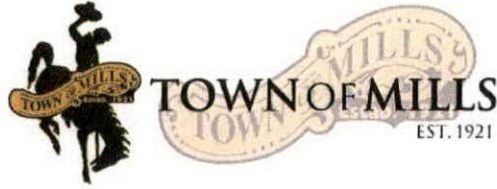

MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor called the meeting to order at 6:00pm.

AGENDA ITEMS

1. Mills School RFP and Appraisal

Mayor:

The Mayor reviewed the agenda for tonight meeting. Asked the council members if there are any questions. Councilman Hollander asked some questions pertaining to the budget. He wanted to know what the hand sanitizer grant was. Mayor stated that Backwards got a loan from a local lender to make sanitizer for the public. The town applied for a grant through the Wyoming Business Council and Backwards is to get us all the receipts that pertains to making the sanitizer. Once we get the receipts then we will send to the Wyoming Business Council to get the money and then we will give to Backwards to pay their loan off. Sabrina stated that we are also going after a FEMA grant that will help reimburse our cost associated with COVID-19.

Sabrina: Mills RFP and School Appraisal:

Sabrina stated to council that the Mills school she has a rough draft of a RFP for the Mills School. But first we have to have an appraisal. We have a company that will do it for \$2,000.00 We can not use the ones that were done a couple of years ago, because of state statues. Councilman Hollander asked what a RFP is. She stated it is a request for proposal. We will do this to get ideas of what we would like to see where the school is at. You all will get a chance to look at it and make the decision on what you think would be good over there.

Councilman Hollander also asked what is happening with the parks. Mayor stated to him to look over the master park plan that the town did on all the parks. Councilman Hollander wanted to know if we had any list of a time frame that we want to get all the parks up and running. Mayor stated that we are looking at adding a splash pad to one of the parks, doing upgrades to Memorial Park. Robertson Hills park is on hold due to funding, but Sabrina is looking into that. Eagle and First Street Park we have to wait till the time frame is up for the current contractor. If the current contractor does not finish then we will take the appropriate actions to getting it done. Councilman Hollander also wanted to know if the person who oversees the projects has inspectors that look over the project. Mike Coleman, Public Work Director stated that WLC has it's own inspectors and they over sea the projects. Councilman Hollander wanted to know what inspector did not do their job from the problems on South 5th Ave. Mayor stated that was done before he came in as Mayor. But the changes the Town has done since that project will ensure that we will not run into those problems again.

Mayor talked about the 307 Proclamation. We are teaming up with Wyoming Financial and pledging that we will support to buy local. They are putting the logo on one of our water towers along with the 307 logo. It will be really nice. Councilman McCarthy stated she saw it in downtown Casper and thought it was really nice.

Sabrina also stated that she is working with the Platte River Trails people on getting a trail along the river and to the west side of town.
