MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Pro Tem McCarthy opened the Work Session at 6:00pm.

AGENDA ITEMS

1. Annie Dundas

Annie talked about her late husband that passed away from suicide. She wants to make more awareness of this illness. She has been working on this project since the passing of her husband. "988" is the hotline number that you call to get support. Not many people know about this number. A person can call or someone can call about a person and maintain anonymous. In Wyoming every two days someone dies from suicide. In 2021 there is a suicide nationally every 11 minutes. This is a huge problem, and we need to make people aware of this illness so people can the help they need. She has a task force that would pay for the police and fire vehicles to get a wrap or sticker on their vehicles just like the "911" on the vehicles now. She is working with Casper and the other municipalities now to see if they will all be on board. The City Attorney stated that there is an article on this and it states that the sticker will be a 8 X 8 square and be placed either on the passenger rear side or by the bumper. Mayor Pro Tem will talk with the Mayor and get back to you.

2. City Attorney:

Lamar Sign Agreement

The City Attorney stated that we have to an agreement for the lease of the sign by Lamar. It is for 10 years or until the pathways gets done. We will have to give them 90 day notice to come take the sign down. The City will be getting \$300 a month instead of \$200.00. The City Attorney stated the Mayor recorded the reading of the Proclamation and recognizing this day. UW recognized it today.

The Community Development Director stated that we did not get awarded the grant for the construction of the pathways. They stated we need more planning and then reapply.


Councilman Neumiller asked if we have approved the RPF for review of surveying. That will be on the next meeting to approve
