SPECIAL MEETING

CALL TO ORDER AND ESTABLISH QUORUM

With a quorum being present, Mayor Norie Garza Gonzalez called the meeting to order at 4:44 p.m.

At 4:44 p.m., Mayor Pro Tem Ruben Plata moved to convene into Executive Session to discuss executive session items pursuant to Texas Gov't Code Section 551.071. Motion was seconded by Councilman Abiel Flores and approved unanimously 5-0.
