City Facility Security Camera and Card Access Discussion

Issue: The City of Minnetrista’s security camera and access control system has reached end of life, requiring direction on updates.

Overview: Installed in 2016 with USA Security’s support, the system’s access control software (ACC5) reached end of life in 2018, and its server hardware and operating system followed in 2023. USA Security provides as-needed support, but the system hardware is unsupported by the manufacturers and uses outdated analog cameras. In 2020, the City Council directed staff to use it until failure; it is now nearing that point.

Options from USA Security:

- Option 1: Update hardware (cameras/keypads) and maintain an on-premises server.
- Option 2: Update hardware (cameras/keypads) and adopt a cloud-based SaaS solution.

Chris Dainels from USA Security will present details at the meeting.

Chris Dainels will be presenting the history and options for this exercise at the meeting.

Financing Options:

- 2025: Authorize the project and pair a 5-year equipment certificate with the water treatment plant bond sale for timely completion.
- 2026: Authorize the project, budget accordingly, and pair a 5-year equipment certificate with the 2026 Street Improvement Project bond sale.

Funding will be split between the general fund and enterprise funds based on item locations.

A “do nothing” option risks failure, which is not advised. The BCA recommends recording devices in booking and interview rooms—likely a future mandate—and Public Safety deems this system essential. Action is preferred over waiting.

Subject: Public Safety Vacant Space Discussion/Advanced Training System

Issue: Public Safety staff have developed a detailed plan to repurpose the unoccupied space in the Public Safety Building and would like to discuss this proposal with the City Council for their input and direction.

Overview: The staff’s proposal involves repurposing the vacant space for two primary purposes. First, the majority of the area would house an advanced firearms training system developed by MILO. This system uses simulated weapon fire within a theater-like environment, offering a wide range of interactive scenarios to train officers in realistic situations. The MILO system is a cutting-edge tool designed to improve decision-making, situational awareness, and firearms proficiency in a controlled, safe setting. Deputy Police Chief Craig Squires will attend the meeting to present a detailed overview of the MILO system, including its specific benefits to the Minnetrista Police Department, such as enhanced training outcomes and reduced risk compared to live-fire exercises.

Second, the remaining portion of the vacant space would be converted into additional storage for the Police Department. The recent addition of a fitness area in the Public Safety Building has significantly reduced available storage space, making it difficult to accommodate equipment, records, and other essential items. This shortage has reached a point where a solution is urgently needed. By incorporating storage into this plan, the proposal addresses both training and logistical needs efficiently. Attached below, you will find a diagram illustrating the proposed layout of this currently vacant space if the City Council approves the plan.

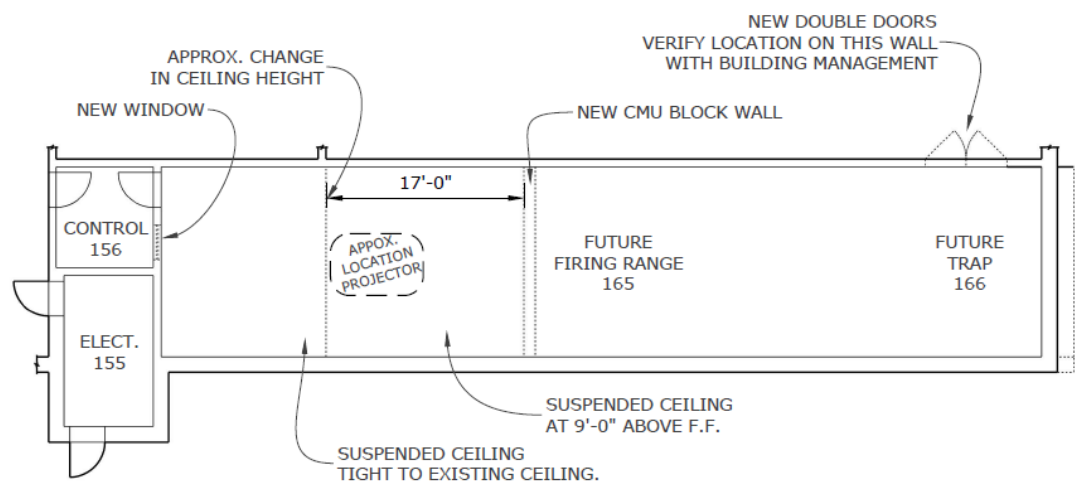
Costs and Funding:
In 2023, the City of Minnetrista received one-time Public Safety Funding from the state, which was divided into two allocations for the Police Department. One portion was used to support operational costs, including salaries and benefits, while the other was set aside for capital purchases. The current balance of the capital purchase allocation, referred to as the Public Safety Funding reserve, stands at \$116,000. After consulting with two commercial contractors, staff estimate that the facility updates required to prepare the

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vacant space—such as electrical work, partitioning, and other modifications—will cost up to \$139,000. Separately, the MILO Advanced Training System has been quoted at \$100,000 by the vendor. When combined with the cost of storage racks and other necessary items, the total budget for this project is estimated at \$250,000.

This total cost is notably lower than the alternative of constructing a live-fire gun range, which was previously discussed and estimated at over \$500,000, not including ongoing maintenance expenses. Staff strongly believe that this proposed solution, featuring the MILO system and storage, is far more practical and cost-effective for the Police Department. The MILO system offers advanced training capabilities at less than half the cost of a gun range, and its maintenance requirements are minimal compared to the substantial upkeep a live-fire facility would demand over time.

To fund this project, staff propose a two-phase approach. First, the remaining \$116,000 in Public Safety Funding designated for capital expenditures would be applied to the construction and facility update portion of the project, covering most of that cost. Second, the purchase of the MILO system and remaining expenses would be included in the City’s 2026 budget. This strategy provides a clear financial pathway to meet the Police Department’s training and storage needs without requiring immediate full funding. Additionally, it’s worth noting that the MILO system could be made available to other police agencies in the region for a nominal fee, creating a small revenue stream to offset costs over time.



Recommended City Council Action: Staff respectfully request that the City Council engage with Public Safety personnel to review and discuss the proposed utilization of the currently vacant space in the Public Safety Building. This discussion will allow staff to address any questions, clarify details, and receive guidance on whether to proceed with the plan as outlined or adjust it based on Council feedback.

Background:

At the February 22, 2025 strategic planning session the City Council directed staff to propose up to \$4 million of proposed street improvements for 2026. Staff proposes the following for the 2026 Street Improvement Project (map attached). Costs shown are for street costs only, including contingency and indirect costs.

North and South Saunders

- Built in 2000
 - 2024 average PCI is 80
 - Full depth removal - a portion of North Saunders Lake Dr, a portion of Basswood Drive, and potentially Cherrywood Ct
 - 2” mill and overlay (with patching) of remaining streets
- \$1,334,000

Lakeside Drive, Lakeside Circle, and Pinnacle Way

- Built in 1997 (Lakeside) and 1999 (Pinnacle)
 - Average PCI is 83
 - 2” mill and overlay
- \$250,000

Game Farm Road

- 3,000 ft west of CR 110 to CR 26 built in 2010
 - Average PCI is 72
 - Full depth reclamation from CR 110 to ~3,900’ west
 - 2” mill and overlay (with patching) of remainder
- \$2,763,000
- Total \$4,347,000**

The City Council could consider adding Game Farm Road (CR 110 to Blair Road) and Blair Road to the state aid system so that state aid funds could be used for Game Farm Road.

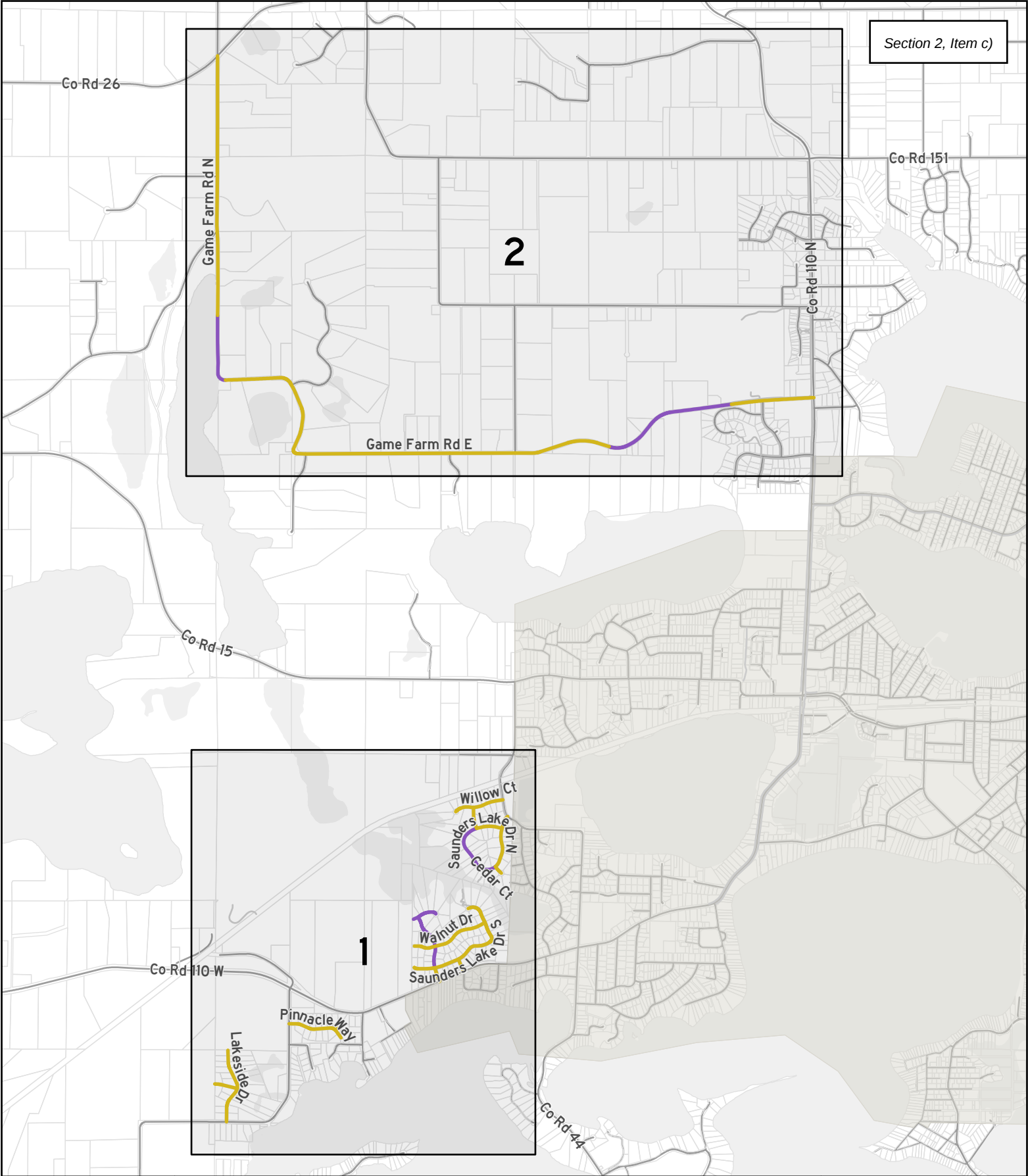
The City of Minnetrista will deliver quality services in a cost effective and innovative manner and provide opportunities for a high quality of life while protecting natural resources and maintaining a rural character.

- The proposed budget for Game Farm Road, CR 110 to Blair is \$968,000.
- The city's current state aid construction fund available balance is \$1,475,096.61. If the 2026 construction fund allocation is the same as 2025, the January, 2026 construction fund balance would be \$1,912,020.61.
- Minnetrista can designate up to 1.85 miles of roads as state aid routes.
 - Game Farm Road from CR 110 to Blair is 1.16 miles
 - Blair Road is 0.50 miles
- State aid routes must connect to trunk highways, county roads, or other state aid routes and requires approval from the state.
- State aid routes must be designated as a collector road, so City Council would have to reclassify Blair Road as a collector road.

Staff will be present at the work session to discuss the proposed scope of the 2026 project and the option to pursue state aid funding.

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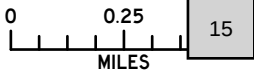

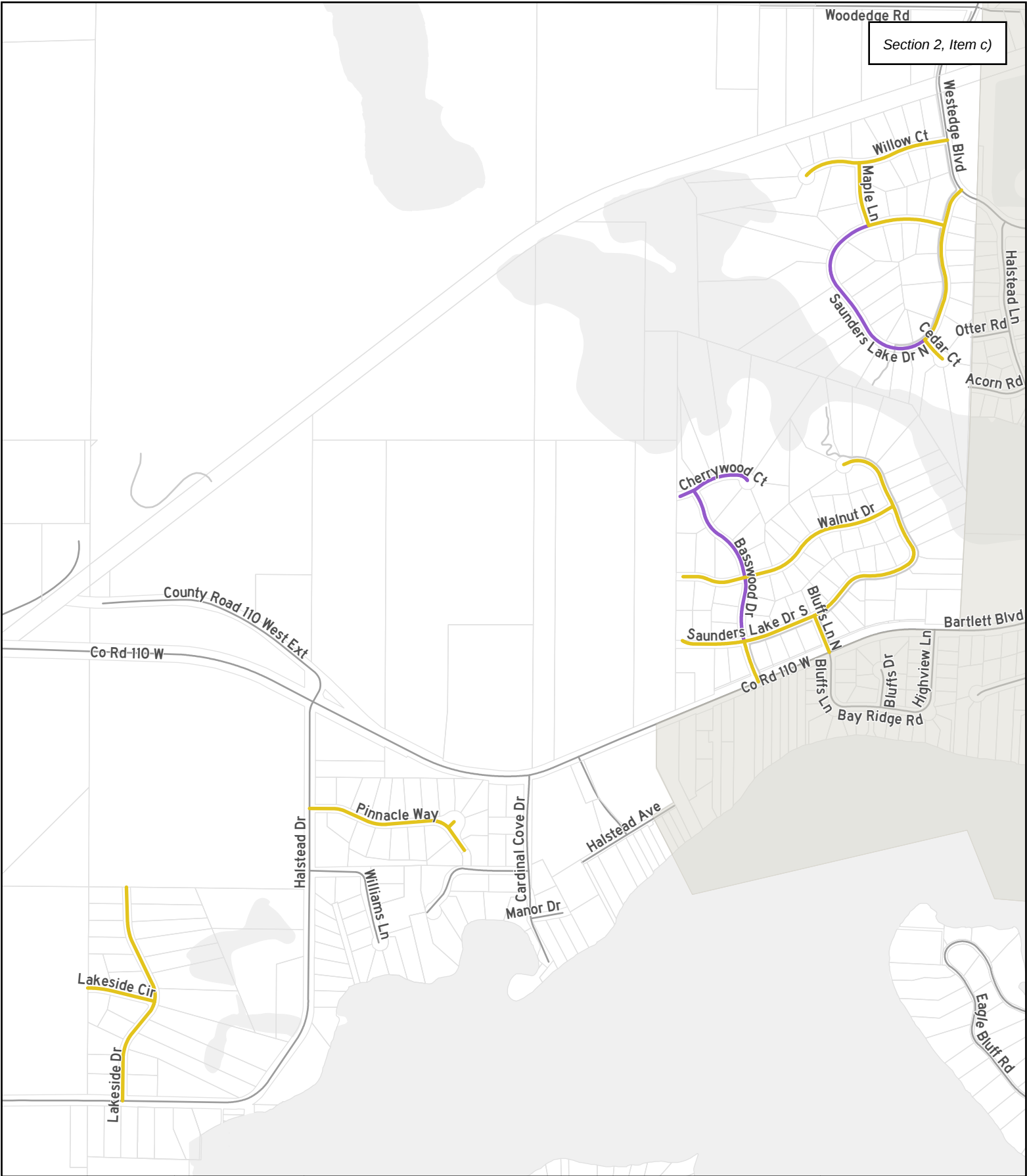

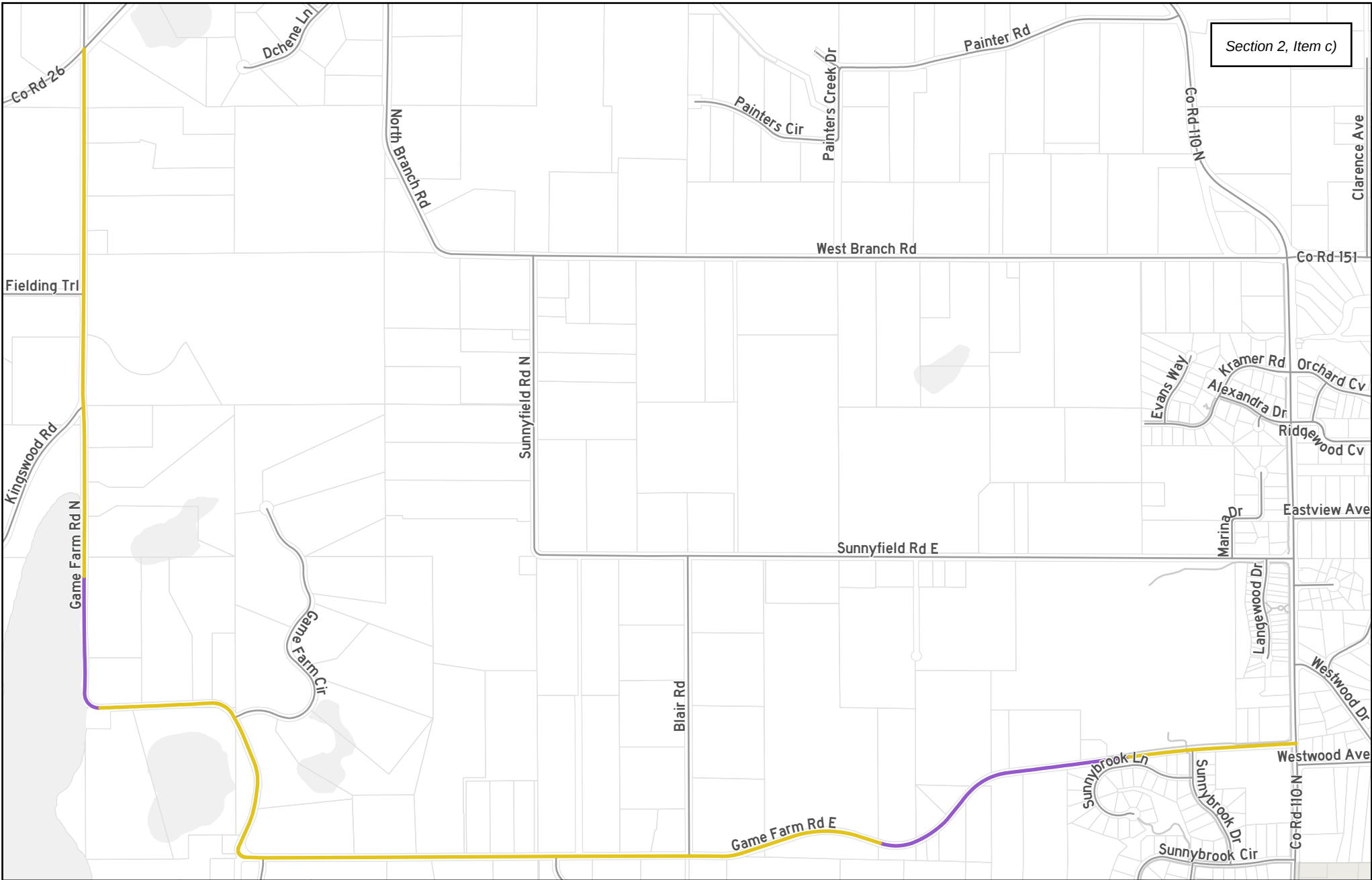
