BACKGROUND:

Organized by Alpha Elite Performance (AEP) and Performance Outdoors, this is a private fundraising event supporting AEP Outdoors and the Green Beret Foundation, both of which are headquartered in Montgomery, Texas. Now in its fourth year, the event features a 5K ruck march through downtown Montgomery, starting and ending at Ransom's.

FISCAL ANALYSIS:

Previously known as "Ruck for Military & March 4 our Military" the event has been referenced as Alpha Elite Performance Outdoors listed under sponsorship in expense reports, though there is currently no dedicated line item for it. According to the event organizer, MEDC has funded this event for the past two years.
