June 21, 2021

President Rebecca Huss called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. Approval of Minutes of Public Hearing and Regular Meeting held on May 17, 2021

Motion to approve the Regular Meeting Minutes was made by Carol Langley and seconded by Byron Sanford. All in favor. (7-0)

APPROVAL OF FINANCIAL REPORT

Approval of April 2021 Finance Report

Finance report was presented by Carol Langley.

Balances are through May 31st. Interest for the Texpool accounts are still 0.01%. Sales tax of \$69,895.77 was received and transferred on June 11th and it will show up on the next finance report. The 6th payment to MISD was made on June 1st for \$63,052.03 for the loan to the General Fund. Payment to Gunda Corporate for the downtown plan was made for \$13,000.

Langley noted that the sales tax is a lot lower than the taxes received in May. Tramm indicated that May was a quarterly payment month. Some businesses pay monthly, and some business businesses pay quarterly. So, quarterly payment months have a higher sales tax revenue.

President Huss noted that the June payment for 2020 was \$54,903.99. This month's revenue when compared to June of last year is a 27% increase.

The finance report did not get a number on the agenda and, as a result, was not voted on.

CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION

2. <u>Update on Goat Mascot Costume which was approved at the May 17, 2021 Meeting, and</u> <u>review of proposed artwork</u>

Presented by Richard Tramm.

Costume purchase was narrowed down to a single company. There are two costume options with the primary differences being the length and curvature of horns as well as the appearance of the beard.

Langley asked if the options are one or the other or if the costume items are interchangeable. Tramm said that it is a custom product so the board can choose parts from one and the other.

President Huss indicated that the breadths of his nose cannot be substantially changed due to visibility as well as closing the mouth.

Langley prefers the horns on option 2 and the beard on option 1. President Huss said that the horns on option 2 more match what is on the goat statue.

Byron asked what effect the beard has as far as performance or anything else. Tramm said, as far as performance, nothing significant. It is a facial feature that is right in line of site with those who are interacting with it. He indicated that Angelo may be better to able to answer the question.

Angelo said that he likes the horns on 2 and the beard on 1. He asked if the board would be receiving a color rendering soon. President Huss said yes but that they wanted buy-in from the board first on the design direction. A woman from the MISD theatre department talked about the goat being whimsical and approachable such as being slightly scruffy and fun rather than

being ominous or angry. So, the beard is scruffy to be more like grandpa's beard and not too barbered.

Tramm indicated that working with the MISD is something that has been cleared with the super intendent and that staff is working with them in a fully open environment. He is thankful that they have experience with costumes and have helped with developing the identity of the character.

There was no motion since it was an action item.

3. Consideration and possible action on mid-year 2020-2021 FY MEDC Budget Amendment

Presented by Tramm.

Tramm indicated there is an increase in the proposed income. The MEDC board initially took a conservative approach with projecting income. This was due to the pandemic and the board didn't want to be in position of projecting a lot of money to be spent that the MEDC would not have with the understanding that if more income came in, these numbers could be adjusted later. In actuality, the City increased income due to people staying in Montgomery and doing business in Montgomery during the pandemic. He is not sure how it will continue in the future. Montgomery came out positively, financially speaking, as a result of the pandemic.

Tramm noted that the MEDC has greater interest income than projected. The City will pay the MEDC back early so there will be a lower than expected interest income for that category.

Tramm indicated that there is now a projected \$200,000 for future downtown development work. This money will be put into a separate texpool account labeled for the downtown improvement project to go toward the next phase of that project. This is intended to slate money toward the big expense item.

Tramm noted a slight change in the sales tax reimbursement category.

Tramm noted that there are a quite a few changes to the events category. Tramm covered a few of the more significant changes.

The southern rum runners is not going to happen as expected and will regroup next spring. He will keep the category for next year but will move this money into another allocation.

Mud bugs and music category was slightly adjusted.

Equipment acquisition was added in order to cover the purchase of equipment to be used at events. He is looking at partial purchase with the City including direction signage. City could also use this equipment when not being used by the MEDC but the equipment would be given to MEDC when needed.

Fall Festival is another Charlie Diggs festival in October with \$9,500 tentatively budgeted from the increase in revenues. Langley indicated that he hasn't asked for that money yet. Tramm confirmed but said that it is coming next month. Langley asked if the money would be spent out of this year's budget. Tramm said the event would out of next year's budget but that a lot of the expenses related to planning would be out of this year's budget leading up to the event in October.

Snow in Historic Montgomery is a new event that will be on the same day as the Christmas parade. It will be an event to allow children of all ages to play in a snow environment. Some of the costs will hopefully be picked up by a corporate sponsor. The event is in December but some of that money will need to be spent ahead of time. Angelo asked for the date of the event. President Huss said the 2nd Saturday in December (11th). She said hopefully it will take all day for the snow to disappear and so people will want to stay in the city longer than the parade to experience the snow. People staying in the city will cause a much bigger economic impact and will create a draw for people to come to the city. Angelo asked where the event would take place. Tramm said that it will be located at 777 Clepper St which is across from the Fernland park. Walker said it is also close to the parade route. Tramm said Fernland will also be open for business too. It will give people something to do and prolong their stay in the city. Angelo asked if someone is heading it up. Tramm said that there are meetings and conversations ongoing with the contractor to lock in a contract. Angelo said he would be happy to help with the event. You could build an entire Christmas scape around it. President Huss said there other opportunities such as the LeFevre property being a craft village as well as the Ransoms property (the train station is underutilized). This is an opportunity to expand that area of downtown. Parking is available. Lot of different things you can do to get people to stay in the city while increasing marketing opportunities. Angelo asked who the snow company is. President Huss said Ice Express is the one the city has spoken to. Handling 40,000 pounds of ice needs a lot of experience. Angelo volunteered to help head up the event. Angelo said he has experience with it already and knows what works and what doesn't. It would also be a good place to host a santa event. Cedar Brake park is okay but not enough parking. President Huss said that parking is iffy due to no parking available inside of the area, but there is local parking nearby and people will be walking from downtown. Parking will be allowed in the school administration parking lot. President Huss said that a corporate sponsor would be nice since it is such a large event. Walker said there a lot of new corporations coming into town who may want to participate. Angelo asked about tying in a charitable component. President Huss said that the MEDC is a non-profit and could presumably work with other charities (Toys for Tots, Food Bank, etc.). Angelo said he has a few in mind including orphan and foster care charities who have a good volunteer base which may help offset some of the labor costs. President Huss said her preference is for kids to be free as a gift to children. Could add an adult belly flop area and dunking tank that could be charged. Tramm said he is willing to run any of these things by the attorney to ensure the MEDC stays within the law. President Huss reminded everyone that Amy, with the quilt walk, would be doing raffle. This is legal as long as the MEDC is doing it since City's cannot do raffles, but EDCs can. The funds from that raffle will help sponsor this event as well.

Tramm said that funds were pulled back from the website category for other use. Funds for

other use including expanding work for the social media consultant to expand the City's social media presence. The consultant has not been asked for more funding, but Tramm thinks it is appropriate to do this.

Tramm said that there are a lot of events coming back. The city used to have a specific position to run events but presently it is City staff's responsibility. Staff is looking for 1500 to engage consultants on a contract basis to take on tasks with putting on events. He has not spoken with anyone yet. He wants to get the item funded first. President Huss said that it is a lot of work and is surprised on how many items are still being taken care of internally. A dirty secret is that money is only made with alcohol. Small events will not make money. If money is not being made then people have to volunteer which leads to a volunteer fatigue problem.

Langley asked if the line item that was consulting for 49,000 was for a full-time position that the City tried 2-3 times to get. Tramm said that no, that line item was previously funded under line item "Admin transfers to general funds" and the line item for hired person was not included for this fiscal year. Langley asked what the money from the MEDC to general fund was going toward? Tramm said to the city staff. Langley asked if the consulting professional service is different than money to general fund. Instead, this is for person that the MEDC had 2 or 3 time before? Tramm said that no, that came out of the admin transfer fund. The MEDC paid the City and the City then paid the person. President Huss indicated that the MEDC cannot have full time employees. Tramm said that this category is added so that MEDC can contract with specific consultants for specific purposes. Langley asked if the MEDC still needs those two large items. President Huss said that the admin transfer will not change at all. The 56004.6 is still social media and will include events. Tramm said that is largely using money that was previously budgeted but not used. The budget was reduced when money was taken out for Reflective Life Media. Difference is made up with reallocation of money that was allocated but not utilized. President Huss asked if the \$34,000 will be just for social media and events consulting? Tramm agreed. Langley asked if the MEDC could hire a consultant because it is for contract services. Tramm said yes because it is not a full-time position. Angelo asked who is vetting these people. Tramm said it falls on his shoulders to carry out the will of the board.

Langley asked if the social media budget was lowered because the category is not being used as much. Tramm said it was because part of that money was used to expand the website, but the social media person has already done a lot of that work. So, money goes up on professional services and down on the website. Social media consultant is doing website work which is a big bargain.

Londeen asked how the \$200,000 for the downtown improvement budget was chosen. Tramm said it basically came to what was left over in the budget. Londeen said the project will obviously be more than that amount, and the consultant hasn't given the MEDC any idea on the cost of the project. Tramm said the MEDC has not, in the past, put tabs on some of the money that's been brought forward. It has been assumed that a lot of the money in the MEDC accounts will go into the downtown area. This is an effort to put a label on that money so that the people can understand what the money is to be used for. It is not just about building a bank account. It has

a purpose. This money will be put into a separate texpool account. Londeen asked if some of the excess cash that the MEDC has now can also be allocated to the project. He said it would be helpful for him and to the public to keep track of where the money is going. It will also show that the MEDC is serious about the downtown improvement project and that it is saving for it. Tramm agreed that putting label on the money is an important detail. Some planned events also do not happen for months away so it is important to set aside money and put a label on it. President Huss said that putting money aside and labeling will help make large projects like this more manageable. Londeen said he would like to know what money is available outside of the \$200,000 budget. Tramm said that money is for this fiscal year and that there is money in the fund balance from previous years. President Huss said the general fund is also like a wedge fund. It is not so much about the money that you save every year. It is also money that can later become the debt service number. She asked Tramm how much money does \$200,000 of debt service cover. Tramm said it goes a long way in a 2% interest environment. President Huss said, for example, the down payment from the fund balance plus this debt service amount could possibly support a bond of \$15 million. She said if the MEDC needs to take on a debt service of \$200,000 it will not have to cut anything out of the budget next year because this money has already been wedged into the annual budget. Tramm said that as the economy grows and as the MEDC brings in additional income, the MEDC can section that additional money to go into that fund. It then becomes fairly painless to fund that bond over its entire life because the seed money has been started and the MEDC is adding to it every year with the economic growth. President Huss reiterated that the wedge would allow future payments to be painless because the money is either being spent on debt service or it is being saved.

President Huss asked if the MEDC needs to get approval from City Council for this. Tramm said no, only for specific expenditures that exceed \$10,000. Londeen asked why you need to get approval for the initial budget but not a budget amendment. Tramm said because the initial budget includes expenditures for items that are \$10,000 or greater and the City has authority over the general nature of the budget. Minor amendments are under the purview of the MEDC if they don't exceed the \$10,000 number. The City will need to approve individual expenditures over \$10,000 in the budget categories that are amended. President Huss clarified that if these items were included in the initial budget, then the MEDC wouldn't need approval for specific expenses over \$10,000.

Motion by Jeff Angelo, seconded by Arnette Easley, to approve the mid-year 2020-2021 FY MEDC Budget Amendment. All in favor. (7-0)

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT REPORTS

4. City Administrator's Development Report

Administrator's report was not presented.

5. <u>City Engineer's Report</u>

Presented by Richard Tramm

Angelo asked about the creation of MUD criteria standard that is currently being discussed. Tramm: a MUD used by developers as a reimbursement vehicle. The City has approved two separate MUDs in its history with different developers that are currently active. The goal is to identify specific standards under three basic questions: 1) How would the approval of a MUD be beneficial to the residents in the MUD and citizens of Montgomery; 2) how does it fit within the broader community; and 3) how does the district benefit the city itself including other residents in the area. Angelo asked if there are proposals now to establish MUD districts. Tramm said there is not one now, but there is one likely in the future. Chances are that there will be more in the future. Staff and attorney are getting more information and getting a firm to come into the City to establish standards that correspond to these criteria.

Walker asked if the city is positioning itself to where someone from the City will be on those MUD boards. Tramm said that is not something that is currently being discussed. Walker said it wouldn't be a bad idea. MUDs are a license to steal essentially. Tramm said that he has been in a couple of MUD boars and that a well-run MUD can be a good thing while an out of control can be a disaster. Angelo said it can get dicey with taxes. Tramm said that the kind of taxes that would be charged in that MUD is a concern the City has, and it is high a priority as far as ordinances is concerned. Easily asked if there is a maximum tax rate that the MUDs can charge. President Huss said that there is a statutory maximum, but they can charge less. Tramm said that a MUD tax max plus other taxes would be a high tax amount and that is why it is a high concern to the City. Huss said that the whole point is to start before the City has MUDs. She thinks MUDs are like Ponzi schemes in that who gets out first, the developer, is happy. Angelo said he'd imagine there has to be some City oversight when the MUD gets started. President said it depends on what is put in place, otherwise no. The point is what do you say to citizens who do not understand why they are paying so much in taxes. Goal is to provide a list of requirements for MUD creation. Angelo: once rules are set will the MEDC know which developer is applying to create a MUD. Tramm said that it does not come to the MEDC board. It will go to Council, and it will be public info. President Huss said the reason to have MUDs is that allegedly developers cannot develop in the City of Montgomery without a MUD because they need development costs reimbursed and the best way to achieve that is through a MUD. Otherwise, the developer would, as an example, need to develop one street at a time. Walker said the benefit is that is helps with growth and someone else can provide these services. President Huss said the City doesn't anyways, the develop does. It is essentially riskier for the City because instead of handling growth one street at a time, the City has to accept more larger service facilities. If the developer goes out of business during development of the property or if there is an economic recession and the houses don't sell then the City spends money on the facilities but doesn't have the extra revenue.

6. Sales Tax Report for May 2021

Presented by Richard Tramm

Sanford asked what "18 sourcing" was under the top sales tax filers list. Tramm said he did not know.

Tramm discussed how online shopping means that those purchases, if delivered to the residence in Montgomery, count as sales revenue to the City.

Sanford asked if the 27 vacant businesses is any concern. Tramm said there is always some amount of vacant business due to transition. Some places are new trying to fill lease space, but there are also some places that have been vacant for a while. If you are at 100% then you cannot bring in new businesses unless they build their own location. He is not saying it is ideal to have vacant places, but you will always have some places that are in transition. President Huss mentioned that there were some long-term vacancies like the slots next to the AT&T store and the business park has not rolled out as quickly as expected.

Langley asked if the financial inspectors just pick a time to come. Tramm said they come out once a year. They are expected to come out again within the next two weeks.

Londeed asked if the hotel tax shown here or elsewhere. Tramm said that is shown elsewhere and not a sales tax item. The City does not have a significant collection under that. President Huss mentioned that hotel / motel occupancy tax would change things quite a bit because it can only be spent in certain ways. You are almost forced to spend it on marketing and advertising.

Walker asked if the Jacobs project is on hold. Tramm said it is essentially is on hold. President Huss said that if he chooses to use AirBnB for that then the City doesn't get HOT money for that. Angelo indicated that those rules may be changing. Tramm agreed.

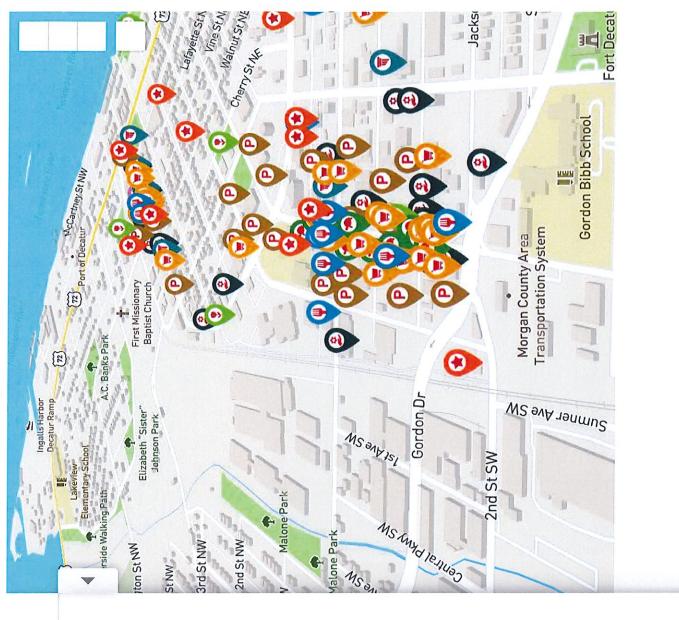

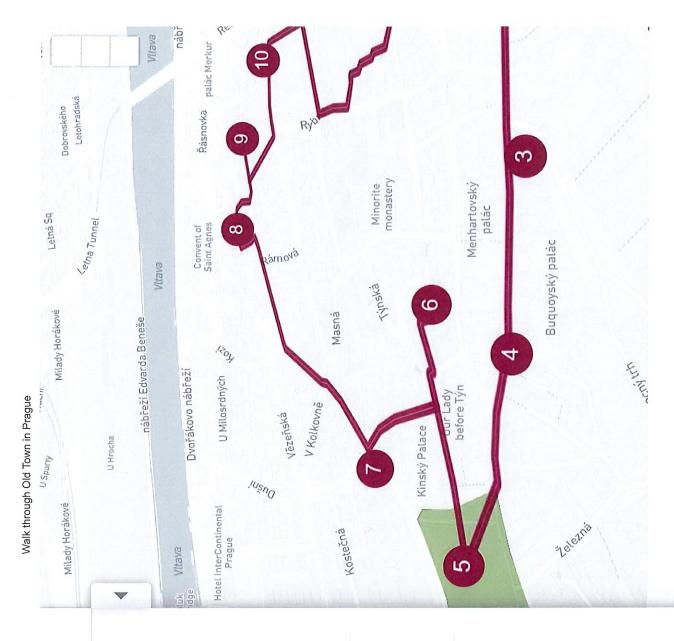

Social Media Review

In June 2020, the MEDC Board of Directors took steps towards refocusing the direction of our social media marketing. We moved to work to increase audience size and concentrate on the local regional audience. During the period of June 2020 to March 2021, the Facebook audience grew from 2,887 to 5,336 Since that time until July 2021, the growth has continued and is over 6,300—literally more than doubling the audience in a year. The top ten cities with people following the Historic Montgomery, TX page are all in the local region and range from Huntsville to Houston geographically. In addition to the primary City account for each Facebook and Instagram, there are now several additional accounts in each representing such separate identities as Public Works, Fernland Historical Park, Monty the Montgomery Goat and even the Quilt Walk has its own event page.

I have attached several pages with data that was used for this report, and I will address some specific points during the meeting.

Dear Mayor and Council:

The following is a brief summary that describes our activities since the May 25, 2021 Council Meeting:

Projects (Jones | Carter):

- 1. Downtown Waterline Replacement It is our understanding the contractor is continuing to work along SH-105. It is also our understanding the plans are in the final stage of review for the FM 149 permit, which will allow the contractor to proceed with work along FM 149.
- 2. Baja Road Water and Drainage Improvements, Phase I & Phase II (CDBG) We are working with GrantWorks and City Staff to close out the project.
- **3.** Water Plant No. 3 Improvements It is our understanding Jones | Carter is working to provide all required documentation to the TWDB before issuing a Notice to Proceed.

4. GLO Projects

- a. Ander's Branch Drainage Improvements It is our understanding Jones Carter is proceeding with environmental and surveying services for the project.
- **b.** Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation It is our understanding Jones|Carter is beginning preliminary design on the project.
- **c.** Water Plant No. 3 Generator It is our understanding Jones Carter is beginning preliminary design on the project.
- 5. FM 1097 Speed Study Jones | Carter is proceeding with the speed study as previously authorized by the City.

Item 9

Developments:

1. Feasibility Studies – There are no active feasibility studies at this time.

2. Development Coordination

- a. Gracepoint Homes (Kammerer Tract) It is our understanding the developer is working with the Public Utilities Commission to decertify the tract from the Dobbin-Plantersville CCN boundaries.
- **b.** Food Truck Park We are coordinating with the developer and City Staff on sanitary sewer service options for the tract.

3. Plan Reviews

Wendy's (Haza Foods) – We received plans from the previous City Engineer on May 26th and rejected the plans due to none of the previous comments having been addressed. We held a call with the developer on June 3rd to discuss the plans due to the time passed since the last submittal.

4. Plat Reviews

a. Town Creek Crossing, Section 1 Final Plat – As a reminder, the council approved a variance for the vegetative buffer at the June 8th meeting of the City Council. We are now proceeding with our review of the final plat and would expect the plat to be presented at the July 13th meeting of the City Council for approval.

5. Ongoing Construction

a. Town Creek Crossing, Section 1 – We plan to meet with Jones Carter to discuss the current status of construction this week and plan to take over inspection duties beginning on June 21st.

6. One-Year Warranty Inspections

- a. Villas of Mia Lago, Section 2 We will continue coordinating with the Developer to ensure the punch list items are addressed.
- **b.** Hills of Town Creek, Section 3 We are coordinating with the Developer's engineer to ensure the punch list items identified at the warranty inspection are addressed.
- **c.** Hills of Town Creek, Section 4 The warranty period for this project will end on March 24, 2022.

General Ongoing Activities:

 Biweekly Operations and Developments Call – We plan to resume the biweekly operations and developments calls with City Staff and H2O Innovations on June 22nd.

- 2. FM 1097 & Atkins Creek Drainage Improvements (TxDOT) We are coordinating with TxDOT to provide any documentation necessary to determine and prepare the easement area that is to be obtained for the project.
- **3.** FM 149 & SH-105 NB Right Turn Lane (TxDOT) TxDOT has advised that the project is let and construction is expected to begin in late September.
- **4. TxDOT's 2021 Transportation Alternatives Call for Projects** We prepared the required exhibits and cost estimates to be included in the application that was submitted on June 14th.
- 5. City Engineer Transition We are working with City Staff and Jones Carter to transition all engineering tasks identified to WGA, as well as obtaining all requested documents from Jones Carter.

Development Report July 2021

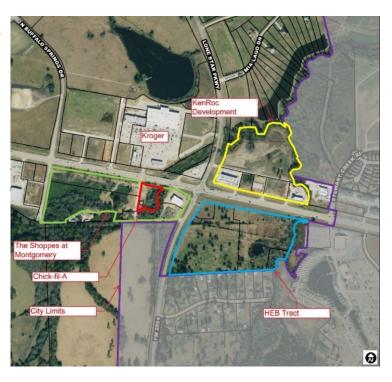

Residential and commercial markets were active and showed strong growth for the first half of 2021. While new home construction starts have outpaced lot delivery by a small margin over the last several years, new developments coming online in the next two months will ensure attractive homesites are available to meet residential market demands. Commercial construction activity continues within existing developments on the east end of the City. We continue to monitor the COVID-19 pandemic and its effects on development. Broadly speaking, short-term effects on City development appear minimal. Longer-term implications for certain market segments remain to be seen, but the City is seeing positive signs in retail sales, as well as in commercial and residential construction.

Commercial Development

East End Commercial

Construction on the east end of Montgomery continues at a steady pace. The 26-acre Shoppes at Montgomery is active with Panda Express, a fast-casual Chinese restaurant chain, under construction. AutoZone is complete and open for business next to McCoy's Building Supply.



Central Business District & Historic Downtown -

No new development activity to report this month.



Residential Development

Existing homesite inventory is limited, but available, and several new residential subdivisions are under development. While uncertainty exists in the market, low mortgage interest rates coupled with a desirable community and relatively low home prices will likely keep demand for new housing strong for the immediate future.

- 28 new homes completed in 2021 (through June 30th)
- 6 new single-family home permits issued in June

<u>Hills of Town Creek Subdivision</u> – Near Montgomery High School on the west side of the City, this subdivision has 130 single-family homesites. Several new home permits have been issued this month for the new 30-lot Section Four addition the subdivision.

<u>Town Creek Crossing</u> – This addition to the Buffalo Springs Planned Development includes 199 residential homesites and eight commercial reserves. Site work is underway with homes expected to begin construction in the coming months.



City Development Activities

Texas Water Development Board Funding - The City is utilizing \$2.8 million in

TWDB funding for water and sewer infrastructure projects that include:

- Downtown + SH105 Waterline. (Began Jan. 2021 and nearing completion).
- Water Plant #3 (starting work soon).
- Lift Station #1 (completed).
- Lift Station #3 Sanitary Force Main Reroute (design complete; process on hold pending final reconciling of cost for above project to determine available funding)

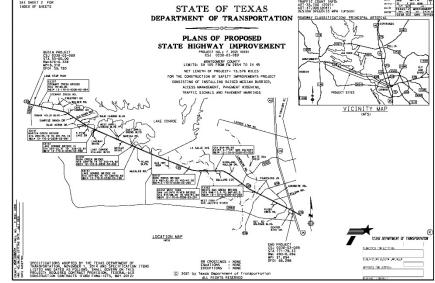
<u>General Land Office Severe Flood Mitigation Grant</u> – In 2018, the City was awarded \$2.2 million from the Texas General Land Office (GLO) for flood-related damages associated with 2016-2018 flooding events, which included the Memorial & Tax Day floods and Hurricane Harvey. A study of the Town Creek and Anders Branch watersheds on the north side of the City is now complete, and projects identified in the study will be implemented with a portion of the grant funds. The work proposed in the study is under review by the GLO and the City is requesting a timeline extension for the project completion due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The City is preparing to move forward with select portions of this grant project.

<u>Minimum MUD Standards</u> – During 2019 and 2020, the City considered a framework of standards for MUD's and other Special Purpose Districts in the City Limits and ETJ. As City staff explored establishing minimum MUD standards, it was realized that each situation would need to be considered according to its individual merits. This led to the creation of a set of statements/questions for the City to use in evaluating future special district creation requests. They are:

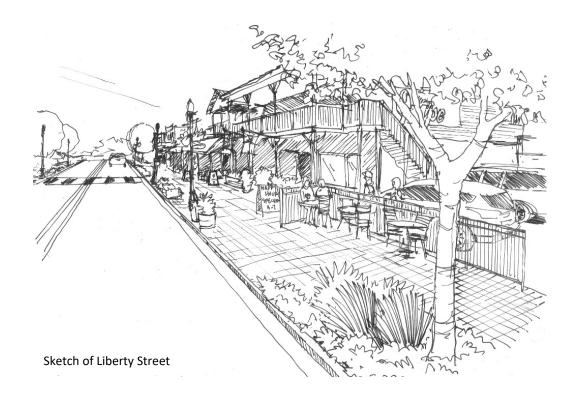
- 1. How does the proposed District benefit its residents? (available amenities, etc)
- 2. How does the proposed District benefit the broader community? (variety of housing options, possible improved commercial development)
- 3. How does the proposed District benefit the City? (fiscally responsible planning, collaborative relationships with developers).

<u>Transportation & Mobility</u> – Several projects are underway to improve mobility in the City for both vehicular traffic and pedestrians.

- <u>FM149 turn lane</u>: The City has been working with TxDOT on a turn lane at the intersection of SH105 & FM149 since early 2019. The turn lane will serve northbound traffic on FM149 turning eastbound on SH105. TxDOT plans to begin work on the turn lane in late September.
- <u>TxDOT 2021 Transportation Alternatives Call for Projects</u>: TxDOT's bi-annual program seeks to improve pedestrian and bicycle facilities on or near TxDOT roads. The City recently submitted two sidewalk projects: one along Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive from FM149 to the City limits, and one connecting the downtown to the public library and Memory Park on Bessie Price Owens Drive. The program provides an 80% grant for awarded projects with 20% local matching funds. Detailed applications were submitted in mid-June and projects will be awarded in October 2021.
- TxDOT SH 105 Access Management Project: TxDOT plans to begin construction of raised medians in key locations between FM 2854 in Montgomery and I-45 in Conroe. This multiyear project will improve safety by reducing cross-traffic turning locations and providing dedicated single-direction turn lanes where the project study identified a need for them. https://www.txdot.gov/inside-More about the project can be found at: txdot/projects/studies/houston/sh105-access.html. 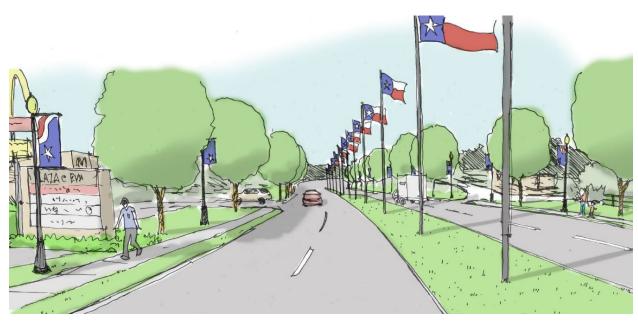
<u>Downtown Improvement Plan</u> – This MEDC-funded project to improve the downtown area is an approximately 7-month project that began in November 2020. The MEDC worked with TAMU landscape architecture students on visioning for the project and has contracted with the Gunda Corporation/White Oak Studio team to lead the design efforts. The team has completed the site analysis preliminary design phases and is working on the final design. Several of the slides from the design team's work are included below.
