SUBJECT: Sequential Urban Growth Boundary Expansion

BACKGROUND: The City of Molalla is currently in the process of completing an updated Housing Needs Analysis and Housing Production Strategy in accordance with HB2003. This work is being funded in large part by a Technical Planning Grant from Oregon Department of Land Conservation and Development (DLCD).

In keeping with the Community Development Department's goal of maximizing the return on dollars spent, City Staff has worked with DLCD and the Technical Advisory Committee to identify a strategy that will allow the work being done for HB2003 to help address the City's extremely outdated Urban Growth Boundary (UGB).

City staff has invited staff from DLCD to provide a class for the Planning Commission and City Council on sequential UGB expansions. This process will allow the City to utilize some of the required information and studies for the HB2003 process on future expansion of the UGB, thus saving the City the costs associated with conducting a stand-alone UGB expansion process.

At the time of this report staff has received confirmation that DLCD will attend the meeting (virtually or in-person) and provide the sequential UGB expansion class, but the identity of the presenters has not yet been disclosed.
