Description:

Public Hearing to discuss 2024 millage rate. Recommend approval of the 2024 millage rate of 6.661 mills, as presented on form PT-38.

Background:

Due to increasing costs associated with maintaining city services, staff recommends a millage rate of 6.661. This is an increase of 0.452 mills over the calculated full rollback & only a .194 mills increase over the 2023 rate. This will give the City of Monroe a prospective 10.03% increase in revenues, which translates to approximately \$500,330 more than 2023 at 100% of collections. The last increase of the City of Monroe's millage rate was in 2019. Despite this increase, the new rate remains amongst the lowest in at least the past 10+ years.

The net maintenance & operations millage rate is 6.661 mills, and the bond millage rate is 0.00, giving a total millage rate of 6.661 mills.

The five-year history of the digest with the current year's digest and levy were properly advertised in the City's legal organ on July 17, 2024 and again on July 28, 2024 as well as the City of Monroe's website. Property taxes will be billed and collected by the Walton County Tax Commissioner's office.
