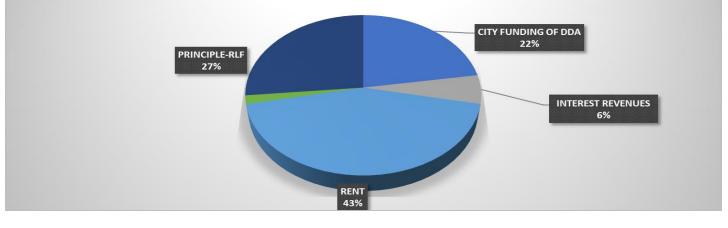

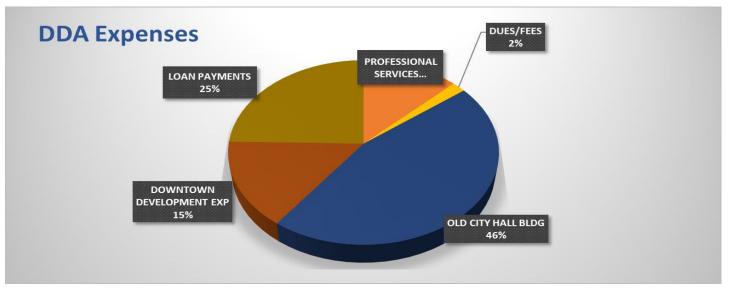

RESOLUTION

Downtown Development Authority of the City of Monroe

WHEREAS, a meeting of the Downtown Development Authority of the City of Monroe (the "Authority") was held on the 13th day of June, 2024; and

WHEREAS, said meeting was held after proper notice and a quorum of the members of the Authority were present;

WHEREAS, the Authority is a downtown development authority formed pursuant to the Georgia Downtown Development Authorities Law, O.C.G.A. §§ 36-42-1 to 36-42-16;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Code Section 36-42-8, the Authority has all of the powers necessary or convenient to carry out and effectuate the purposes of the Georgia Downtown Development Authorities Law;

WHEREAS, JEC Development LLC ("Borrowers") desires to renovate a certain real property located at 129 North Wayne Street, Monroe, Georgia ("Property");

WHEREAS, in order to finance the leasehold improvements of the Property, Borrowers have obtained approval for a loan from the Georgia Cities Foundation, Inc.;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the guidelines of the Georgia Cities Foundation's Revolving Loan Fund program, such loan funds must be made to a city's downtown development authority or similar entity, which will in turn utilize these funds to make a similar loan for a downtown revitalization project.

NOW, **THEREFORE**, it was upon motion and adopted as follows:

The Authority is authorized to accept a loan in the amount of <u>\$200,000</u> from the Georgia Cities Foundation, with such loan to be used towards the cost of renovations at a building located at 129 North Wayne Street in downtown Monroe. The Authority will and is hereby authorized to provide a loan in the same amount to JEC Development LLC. for the renovation at a building located at 129 North Wayne Street in downtown Monroe for a restaurant tenant.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Authority is authorized to make such assignments, guarantees, indemnity agreements, escrow agreements, and execute such other documents as necessary to close this transaction.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman, Vice-Chairman, and/or Secretary of the Authority are hereby authorized to execute such agreements,

contracts, assignments, promissory notes, or other documents as necessary to carry out the above-described project.
