AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MORGAN'S POINT RESORT CITY, TEXAS ESTABLISHING WHICH CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS WILL SERVE INITIAL ONE- AND TWO-YEAR TERMS OF OFFICE; PROVIDING FOR THE FOLLOWING: A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; EFFECTIVE DATE; AND PROPER NOTICE AND OPEN MEETING

WHEREAS, the City of Morgan's Point Resort City, Texas is a governmental entity that was incorporated pursuant to the laws of the State of Texas as a Type A General-Law Municipality; and,

WHEREAS, Chapter 23 of the Texas Local Government Code authorizes the governing body of a general-law municipality such as the City of Morgan's Point Resort City, Texas to create staggered terms of office for the mayor and city council; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council established staggered, two-year terms of office for city council members at is August 12, 2025 .

WHEREAS, the City Council members drew lots to determine which council members would serve a one-year term and which council members would serve a two-year term.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Morgan's Point Resort City, Texas:

The terms of office of the city council shall be staggered so that a portion of the city council shall be elected each year. Exceptions shall apply as specified in section 4 below.

4. INITIAL APPLICATION

- A. The two council members who serve two-year terms shall be determined by drawing lots by the members of the city council at the meeting of the city council on August 12, 2025 following the adoption of this ordinance at the city council meeting held on July 8, 2025.
- B. The remaining three council members shall receive one-year terms. These one-year terms shall expire on the November 2026 uniform election date established by the Texas Legislature.
- C. The mayor shall serve a two year term.
- D. Thereafter, regular terms of office for the mayor and all members of the city council shall be for two years, unless otherwise provided by law.

5. EFFECTIVE DATE

- A. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
- B. The appropriation of staggered, two-year terms under this Ordinance shall be effective as provided in section 4 above.

6. SEVERABILITY

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the city council that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this Ordinance be severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs or sections of this Ordinance, and the remainder of this Ordinance shall be enforced as written.

7. PROPER NOTICE AND MEETING

It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance was passed was open to the public as required and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code.

ORDINANCE NO. 25-017

TERMS OF OFFICE

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MORGAN'S POINT RESORT CITY, TEXAS ESTABLISHING STAGGERED, TWO-YEAR TERMS OF OFFICE FOR THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL; PROVIDING FOR THE FOLLOWING: A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; EFFECTIVE DATE; AND PROPER NOTICE AND OPEN MEETING

WHEREAS, the City of Morgan's Point Resort City, Texas is a governmental entity that was incorporated pursuant to the laws of the State of Texas as a Type A General-Law Municipality; and,

WHEREAS, Chapter 23 of the Texas Local Government Code authorizes the governing body of a general-law municipality such as the City of Morgan's Point Resort City, Texas to create staggered terms of office for the mayor and city council; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the establishment of staggered, two-year terms of office is in the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Morgan's Point Resort City, Texas:

1. GENERAL ELECTION DATE

The general election date for the offices of mayor and city council in the City of Morgan's Point Resort City, Texas shall be the uniform election date in November of each year, as may be established and modified by the Texas Legislature.

2. TWO-YEAR TERMS

The regular term of office for the positions of mayor and members of the city council shall be two (2) years.

3. STAGGERED TERMS
