Budget Overview:

Council discussed and prepared a balanced budget with targeted cuts and increases. Property tax cuts considerations reviewed, town receives 8 mills; 8 mills to remain the same. Water rate clarification; water base rate increases by \$1.00, no increase to per gallon usage. No other public comment beyond clarification.
