CALL TO ORDER

NEW BUSINESS

YAHA (Youth Alternative Home Association) Contract

D'andrea Chichester, Director of YAHA, presented a proposal to partner with the Town of Mountain View. Service Statistics (FY 24-25):

Provided 5 placements for Mountain View youth, totaling 56 days of care, valued at approximately \$8,400.

Conducted two parenting classes for local families, one of which was court-ordered.

Service Statistics (Current Year as of April 1st):

Provided 9 placements, totaling 467 days of care, valued at an estimated \$70,000.

About 60% of this cost is covered by grants from the Department of Family Services.

Three parenting classes were held; two were court-ordered.

Partnership Opportunities:

YAHA is seeking community service projects for youth during the summer, such as park cleanup or painting benches.

A week or two notice is requested for scheduling projects.

Motion by Council Member Tims, seconded by Council Member Brunski-Deckert, to enter into contract with YAHA for \$1,250, motion carried.
