SUBJECT: Discussion and consideration of amending the Midwest City Police Department

"Animal Services Center Surgical Room" grant based on lower prices and

additional needs of the new facility.

The Midwest City Police Department applied/received a hospital authority grant for \$32,340.00 to fund a surgical room at the new Animal Welfare Services Center. Because original equipment pricing estimates are lower, the total amount necessary for the surgical room is \$24,125.00, which includes freight and shipping.

We are requesting consideration to amend the original grant and allow the remaining balance of \$8,215.00 be used for other unexpected needs within the facility, specifically office furniture. The City recently purchased office equipment from ABC Enterprise and the product presents a durable and modern look that will complement the new shelter. If approved, these monies will provide office furniture for the animal services center supervisor and the four animal services center officers.

This action is at the discretion of the Board of Grantors.






