District Number Three, City of Midwest City, Oklahoma (North Side

Improvement Increment District)

The Local Development Act Review Committee ("Committee") is tasked with making findings and recommendations to the Midwest City Council ("Council") regarding the conditions establishing the eligibility of the Sooner Rose Increment District. Committee recommendations must include the analysis used to project revenues over the life of the project plan, the effect on the taxing entities and the appropriateness of the approval of the proposed plan and project.

Prior to approval by Council, the Committee must consider and determine whether the project plan will have a financial impact on any taxing jurisdiction and business activities within the proposed district and shall report its findings to Council. The approval of any district plan or project by the Council must address any findings of such impact by the Committee.

This marks the first presentation of the Sooner Rose Increment District Project Plan. It is the Committee's priority to recommend that the project plan be approved, denied or approved subject to conditions set forth by the Committee.
