

SUBJECT : Presentation by Freese and Nichols and Council discussion and review regarding the current sewer moratorium study for the east side of Midwest City including the upkeep of the infrastructure and new connections to the Midwest City wastewater collection system.

In reference to the moratorium passed by City Council on August 22, 2023 by resolution.

At the same meeting of the moratorium; City Council amended the agreement with Freese and Nichols (FNI) for studying the sewer system. In the amendment, they are tasked with examining possible financial scenarios for which the sewer system can be improved such that there is adequate capacity. They have also done a more in depth study of our existing lift stations where capacity issues were noted.

There will be a presentation by staff and FNI on the findings of this study.
