**Meeting Date:** June 27, 2023 City Council Resolution No. 2023-41 Title: A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Needles, California Amending Resolution 2022-26 at the Rivers Edge Golf Course **Background:** On March 22, 2022, the City Council adopted the Membership Rates depicted in Exhibit A. Touchstone has identified in our Competitive Market Analysis Study Rivers Edge Golf Course is priced far below the market. In order to keep pace with increased wages and commitment to improve the golf course maintenance a new fee structure has been proposed: Increase of 10% across the board for all Membership Rates. Attached is the breakdown of fees. For Fiscal Year 2023 the golf course received \$685,299 in revenues and expenses were \$1,037,886. The shortfall is subsidized by general fund tax dollars. **Fiscal Impact:** Increase in Rivers Edge Golf Course Revenues by approximately \$20,000 annually. ## **Background:**

The City Council of the City of Needles in its capacity as Successor Housing Agency to the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Needles approved the policies for the implementation and administration of the Neighborhood Beautification Program. The Low- and Moderate-Income Housing Asset Fund (the "LMIHAF") has allocated \$260,000 towards 13 projects with the remaining balance (currently estimated to be \$39,904) reserved for Program administration purposes.

The purpose of the program is to provide up to \$20,000 of LMIHAF funding for the correction of any exterior physical deficiencies to structures, fences, landscaping, and other related appurtenances that are visible from a public right-of-way (as defined within the Program Policies), with priority given to code-related improvements.

On July 12, 2022 the City Council awarded the Contractor Services for the Neighborhood Beautification Program to Brack Construction Inc. Brack Construction has completed six (6) projects with a total of \$99,046 spent from the Low- and Moderate-Income Housing Asset Fund (the "LMIHAF") towards the following projects:

- 1324 Larchwood Street (\$18,090)
  - Wrought Iron Gate, Driveway extension, repaint trim on house.
- 1332 Larchwood Street (\$21,875)
  - Replacement of damaged roof.
- 207 Monterey Avenue (\$19,466)
  - Installation of new windows (5), paint and repairs to the house, and installed a new fence.
- 115 Monterey Avenue (\$20,000)
  - Painted house and completed stucco patching work, new garage door, landscaping,
- 233 Spruce Street (\$20,000)
  - Replacement of damaged roof, painted house and completed stucco patching work.
- 4 Crestview Drive (\$19,615)
  - Graded dirt to improve failed slope of yard, installed a fence for safety protection, painted house and completed stucco patching work.
