Large-Scale Future Land Use Map Amendment from Alachua County Rural/Agriculture to City
of Newberry Agriculture for Patrick M. Post

Legislative Second Reading for Ordinance 2025-50.

An ordinance of the City of Newberry, Florida, amending Ordinance No. 4-91, as amended, relating to an a large-scale amendment to the Future Land Use Map of the City of Newberry Comprehensive Plan; providing for a change in land use classification from Alachua County Rural/Agriculture (less than or equal to 1 dwelling unit per 5 acres) to City of Newberry Agriculture (less than or equal to 1 dwelling unit per 5 acres), on certain lands within the corporate limits of City of Newberry, Florida; Parcel Number 02515-004-003 consisting of approximately 111 contiguous acres; providing severability; repealing all ordinances in conflict; and providing an effective date.

An ordinance of the City of Newberry, Florida, amending the Official Zoning Atlas of the City of Newberry Land Development Regulations; providing for rezoning from Alachua County Agriculture (A) to City of Newberry Agricultural (A) on certain lands within the corporate limits of City of Newberry, Florida, consisting of 111 acres and more particularly described in Exhibit A; providing severability; repealing all ordinances in conflict; and providing an effective date.
