1. Fiscal Year 2021 Budget - Proprietary Funds:

To include Electric, Water and Wastewater Utilities, Utility Administration and Billing

<u>Manager New</u> and <u>Director Lee</u> provided a PowerPoint overviewing the proposed FY 2020-2021 Proprietary Funds Budget.

Electric Utility: 1.0% increase across residential and nonresidential.

- Residential
 - Average impact per customer is \$1.00 per month.
- Nonresidential; Non-demand Single Phase and Non-demand Three phase
 - Average impact per customer is \$1.50 per month.
- Nonresidential; Demand Three Phase
 - Average impact per customer is \$20 per month.

Water Utility: 1.79% increase across residential, nonresidential, and irrigation.

- Residential
 - Average impact on customer is approx. \$0.25 per month.
 - Lowest rates in peer group.
- Nonresidential (excluding government accounts)
 - Average impact on customer is approx. \$0.50 per month.
 - Lowest rates in peer group.
- Irrigation (excluding government accounts)
 - Average impact on customer is approx. \$0.80 per month.

Waste Water Utility: 0% increase in rates.

Lowest in peer group
