2. New commercial building in The Square at Newberry Town Center at Country Way.

Quasi-Judicial Public Hearing: Resolution 2022-44/Application SDP 22-10, an application by Chris A. Potts, PE, Agent for Norfleet-Green Development II, LLC, Owner, for a Site Development Plan approval for approximately 2,400 square feet of commercial use providing additional seating area for an existing restaurant, known as Building 2B, located at The Square within the Newberry Town Center at Country Way Planned Development on ±8.53 acres (Parcel No. 02544-003-000).

Potts, PE, Agent for Norfleet-Green Development II, LLC, Owner, for a Site Development Plan approval for approximately 13,500 square feet of mixed use containing 6,704 square feet of gym space and 6 dwelling units on ±8.53 acres (Parcel No. 02544-003-000).
