PUBLIC HEARINGS AND ORDINANCES

1. Wastewater Treatment Facilities Plan

Assistant City Manager Jones introduced Mr. Justin deMello, Woodard & Curran.

Mr. deMello presented a PowerPoint presentation overviewing the following.

- SRF Loan Process
- Clean Water Facility Plan
- Alternative Selection Criteria
- Alternative Selections: project cost, rate payer cost, and environmental impacts
 - o Biological Treatment
 - o Tertiary Treatment
 - o Effluent Discharge
 - Solids Dewatering
 - Residuals Management
- Total project cost estimate, and
- Anticipated Construction Schedule

A lengthy discussion ensued regarding the Clean Water Facility Plan, Alternative Selections, cost of project, and a Regional Wastewater Plant.

Attorney Walker read Resolution 2022-32 by title only.

Motion made by Commissioner Marden to

- 1. Adopt Resolution 2022-32 adopting the City of Newberry Wastewater Facilities Plan prepared by Woodard & Curran, and
- 2. Authorize staff to transmit the City of Newberry Wastewater Facilities Plan to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection, and
- 3. Authorize staff to initiate the design phase process to enter a contract with a qualified designer.

Seconded by Commissioner Coleman.

2. Loan Application to Florida State Revolving Fund Loan Program - Drinking Water Facilities

- 1. Adopt Resolution 2022-34 authorizing staff to transmit a loan application for the Florida State Revolving Fund Loan Program for Drinking Water Facilities, and
- 2. Authorize staff to initiate development of a planning document / facilities plan with a qualified firm.

Seconded by Commissioner Mazon.
