Quasi-Judicial Public Hearing, Second Hearing: DA-LDR 21-23, a development agreement proposed to be entered into between the City of Newberry and Joseph J. and Teresa L. Hoffman, Owners. The land which is the subject of the Development Agreement is located on the south side of West Newberry Road, addressed as 20785 and 20737 West Newberry Road, and identified as Alachua County Parcel Numbers 01923-005-000 and 01923-005-001, respectively, consisting of ±18.48 total acres. The property is also the subject of an associated, separate application to amend the existing site's zoning from Agricultural (A) to Commercial, Intensive (CI) which is the Planning & Zoning Boardrecommended classification. The CI zoning classification limits building intensity to maximum Floor Area Ratios from 1.0 to 0.50 for properties between one and twenty acres and requires no portion of any structure shall exceed 72 feet high. The Development Agreement addresses compliance with design and landscaping requirements resulting from the Community Visioning process, connection to water prior to development, and connection to wastewater when available. The proposed Development Agreement provides that necessary infrastructure improvements and design considerations are in place at the appropriate time.
