#### **NEW BUSINESS**

2. Quasi-Judicial Public Hearing of SE 20-01, An application by EDA engineers-surveyorsplanners, Inc., Agent for Store Master Funding XI, LLC, Owner, for a Special Exception in the "A" Agricultural Zoning District, in conformance with Section 4.2.41 of the Land Development Regulations, to allow the operation and expansion of an existing commercial small animal boarding facility on approximately 4.88 acres located at 19518 West Newberry Road (Tax Parcel 04265-008-000).

Mayor Marlowe read the Quasi-Judicial Procedures.

<u>Clerk Rice</u> swore in <u>Director Thomas</u>, <u>Mr. Clay Sweger</u>, EDA Consultants Inc.; <u>Mr. Brian</u> <u>Franco</u>, Pet Paradise Real Estate Vice President; and <u>Mr. Wayne Tharp</u>, citizen.

Mayor Marlowe asked for ex parte communication.

City Commissioners disclosed receipt of an email from <u>Mr. Wayne Tharp</u>. <u>Commissioner</u> <u>Marden</u> responded to the email. <u>Chair Coleman</u> did not open the email. <u>Commissioners</u> <u>Norfleet</u>, <u>McKinley</u>, and <u>Farnsworth</u> read the email but did not respond. <u>Mayor Marlowe</u> disclosed hearing parts of this discussion during the Planning and Zoning Board meeting, but does not have a vote during this proceeding.

Attorney Walker advised the Commissioners to forward the email to Clerk Rice for record.

Attorney Walker read Resolution 2020-17 by title only.

# PUBLIC HEARING OPEN

<u>Director Thomas</u> presented staff overview with conditions as stated in the resolution with a PowerPoint.

Mr. Sweger and Mr. Franco presented the applicant PowerPoint presentation.

<u>Director Thomas</u> provided the staff recommendation to adopt Resolution 2020-17/Special Exception Application SE 20-01, with conditions.

Mayor Marlowe asked for public comment.

Mr. Tharp spoke in opposition of the resolution and expressed concerns.

There was no cross-examination.

Mr. Franco addressed the concerns of Mr. Tharp.

<u>Director Thomas</u> informed the Commission that there are no complaints on record from Code Enforcement or Alachua County.

Mayor Marlowe asked if there were comments from the Commission.

<u>Commissioner Norfleet</u> stated that it does not seem that the facility is zoned appropriately as agriculture. <u>Director Thomas</u> and <u>Mr. Sweger</u> responded to his comment. <u>Attorney</u> <u>Walker</u> addressed the agriculture zoning and special exemptions.

No final argument from the applicant and staff.

# PUBLIC HEARING CLOSED

Attorney Walker reminded the Commission of applicable law.

Discussion ensued.

Motion made by <u>Commissioner Marden</u> to adopt Resolution 2020-17/Special Exception Application SE 20-01, with conditions including items 1-10 and excluding item 11.

Seconded by Commissioner Coleman.

Voting Yea: Commissioner Marden, Chair Coleman, and Commissioner McKinley.

Voting Nay: Commissioner Norfleet and Commissioner Farnsworth
