#### **PUBLIC HEARINGS AND ORDINANCES**

2. Public Hearing on a Site and Development Plan petition for a 4,500 square foot commercial building including a drive-through restaurant use and related site development.

Quasi-Judicial Public Hearing: Resolution 2022-74/SDP 22-12, an application by JBrown Professional Group, Inc., dba JBPro Group, Inc., Agent for Daytona Terroir, LLC, Owner, for a Site and Development Plan approval for a 4,500 square foot commercial building including a drive-through restaurant use and related site development on  $\pm 0.78$  acres (Parcel No. 01945-001-000).
