Quasi-Judicial Public Hearing: Resolution 2020-08/STUP 20-01, an application by the City of Newberry, Agent for Patrick McKenzie Post, Owner, for a special permit for a temporary use to allow a one-day outdoor concert, as provided in "Section 14.10.1. Temporary use permits issued by city commission" of the City of Newberry Land Development Regulations, to be held April 18, 2020 as Newberry's 4th annual WestFest Music Festival, on property approximately 216 acres in size, located adjacent to the Alachua County/Gilchrist County Line on the southeast corner of West Newberry Road/SR 26 and SW 298th Street (Gilchrist County Road 2085/SE 90th Avenue).

Attorney Walker read Resolution 2020-08 by title only.
