





## **Unita Basin Railroad Project**

- ➤ In January 2022, the Surface transportation Board approved the construction of Unita Basin Railroad's 85-mile short-line railroad project to connect oilfields in Western Utah to the national rail network. Construction is set to begin in 2023.
- > The purpose of this railroad is to connect drilling operations in NE Utah's Uinta (you-went-ah) Basin to the refineries in Texas and Louisiana.
- The project has federal approval, but the project faces new hurdles after Eagle County along with other counites, towns and other conservation groups sued the Federal Surface Transportation Board to require a deeper environmental investigation. Dozens of other cities and counties in Colorado have also asked the state's U.S. senators to intervene.
- > The Uinta Basin Railroad project in Utah could bring up to 10, two-mile-long waxy crude oil trains, alongside I-70 through Silt and New Castle, along the Colorado River.
- A waxy crude is defined as a crude oil having a high pour point and low API gravity, and often containing paraffin wax (alkanes). A waxy crude is distinguished by the fact that it exhibits non-Newtonian viscosity behavior at temperatures below about 20F above the pour point (it needs to be a certain temperature to transport without it crystalizing and turning into mostly wax).
