ROLL CALL / PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Committee Members Diane Markham, Joe and Olivia Sullivan, Angie Crow, and Angie Mettie were present at City Hall.

Deputy Clerk Diane Hunter was present.

Members of the public present was Kenn Roller.

The meeting was opened at 6:06 P.M.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

Baseball

Scheduling of baseball games has been an issue, as McCall has scheduled games without communicating with New Meadows coaches, the City, or Parks and Rec. T-Ball Coach Roller attended the meeting to discuss the game schedule and who to contact regarding games. The schedule has been shared with all coaches. All communications will run through Diane Markham.

Summer Sports Equipment Request

The Planet Youth Coordinator asked the opinion of Parks & Rec on paying a high school student to set out sports equipment at the park this summer. After discussion, the Committee felt that allowing the equipment to be checked out from the library was the best idea.

Bike-A-Thon Awards

The Bike-A-Thon fundraiser was set for May 10th. There were 14 participants. Committee Member Markham felt it would work better if riders signed up previous to the event so that the Committee could be prepared with the correct amount of food and help. Winners were invited to the meeting to pick up their bikes, but did not attend. Deputy Clerk Hunter will contact them and let them know they can pick up their prizes at the City. The money that was raised will go to the bike park.

Mural Project

At the previous meeting, the Committee worked with Mayor Good on a timeline for the project. A timeline included a submissions deadline by October 15th. Advertisement will occur throughout the summer. Finalist could be chosen by January / February, and the mural could start in the spring / summer of 2025. Mayor Good will look at the flyers and update them with the correct dates. They then will be distributed. It was suggested that all ages, or at least those 25 and under, be included in the contest so that all artists in Meadows Valley could be a part of the contest. This idea will be discussed with Mayor Good.

Financial Report

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Farmers Market

Committee Member Markham suggested that community members who have lived in New Meadows for a long time, share photos or images that could be displayed at the Farmers Market to help inspire any who are interested in entering the mural contest.
