ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS AMENDMENT

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEW MEADOWS, IDAHO, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 401-2024. THE APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2024; APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONIES THAT ARE TO BE SPENT BY THE CITY OF NEW MEADOWS, IDAHO, IN THE SUM OF \$596,912; DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO FILE A CERTIFIED COPY OF THIS ORDINANCE WITH THE IDAHO SECRETARY OF STATE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW MEADOWS, ADAMS COUNTY, IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 401-2024 the appropriations ordinance for the City of New Meadows, Idaho, for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 2024, be, and the same is hereby amended as follows:

That the additional amount of \$596,912 be appropriated out of revenues from cash on hand in the sum of \$596,912 to be used for authorized activities.

Section 2. The City Clerk of the City of New Meadows is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the Idaho Secretary of State, in accordance with Idaho Code 50-1003.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication.
