At the front desk:

- There were six home purchases or new renters who moved in this month.
- Many called with frozen pipes, thinking the City shut their water off. Many feel that it is the meter that freezes, not their pipes. I am working on a brochure for what to do when pipes freeze, and how to prevent this. Daniel has been called several times to check meters, which are usually buried under snowbanks.
- Several asked to have water shut off while they are away for the winter. A few shut-offs have been difficult, as most meters are under snow, and their location is unknown.
- A customer called concerned with high usage on his water bill in December. The house is empty, as the owners do not live here. Average usage is 1000 gallons, with highest usage ever being 4000 gallons. In December, 15,000 gallons were used. His property did not show up on the leak report. Daniel will make sure the meter is working properly and that it isn't running.
- The school also has been in contact regarding a large leak. I have provided data logs for the last two months and they are diligently working to find the leak.

willing to sub-contract with the city to take on the project, or be a consultant, if the Council wished to hire him. The project would need to be researched and will take a lot of work.

- FIRE HYDRANT PROJECT: I am working on a fire hydrant certificate and brochure on how to care for your hydrant. I also will have a map of hydrants available at city hall to show hydrant adoption status.
- METER MAP: I am working on a map of water meters that will be completed when the snow melts. Old logs show that some meter locations are unknown. It has been important this winter to know their location, and time is wasted looking for them.
- ANNUAL CALENDAR: Our white board will be turned into an annual calendar for the council chambers. If you know of dates you will be gone, or want to add agenda items to certain meetings, you will soon be able to do this at council meetings.

Since our last staff report I have been busy with plowing after the snow storms. We have been going into work around 1230am and getting done between 9am and 11 am. I have dug out the hydrants a couple times and plan to donut again this week since we have a slow down in snow. In between plowing snow I have also addressed several issues with people losing water. All issues so far have been past the meters and typically under a home. With the current lull in snow I will be conducting maintenance of all the snow chains, checking all fluids in the machines and ensuring we are ready for the next storm. Since the last update we had a flat tire on the loader. We had the bead ring replaced and it seems to be working for now. I have discovered a leak at the school and will be working with them to get it repaired. The school meter is not able to be shut off and needs to have a new splitter installed.

January 10, 2022

Winter continues to bring unexpected challenges including multiple reports of frozen pipes and right-of-way issues with snow removal. City Staff are working diligently to do their jobs in a professional and efficient manner. The snowfall patterns don't always coincide with the City's planned plowing schedule, but the staff does the very best that they can.

The heaters for the two Industrial Park units should be installed soon. There was a small delay in getting the stainless steel flue piping. I have requested that the heater in the meat shop be inspected also to determine if it is needing replacement as well.

The Adopt-A-Fire Hydrant program is off to a good start. I have been speaking with individuals to encourage them to adopt their hydrant and several have responded positively. We will continue to get the word out. Please promote this program as it is a way to maintain safety in our community.

I will be introducing myself with a phone call to any new city utility customers so I can become more familiar with those who are moving into our community. I will follow up with a personal note sent to their mailing address. Angie and I are working on a "Welcome to New Meadows" kit that will have information about our community to be shared with new residents. We will also have an information kit to be sent to area Realtors to send out if they have people interested in moving to the area. Even though we don't have a local chamber of commerce at this time, the city has the opportunity to promote our community and all the benefits of living here.

I am requesting that the City Council approve my continued involvement in the Stibnite Foundation, Stibnite Advisory Council and West Central Mountains Economic Development Council for the coming year as the City's representative on those committees. The benefits to our community from these organizations is extremely valuable and I would like to continue representing the City's viewpoints and input. Thank you for supporting me in these endeavors.

I have asked Angie to present training materials to prepare the City Council for an upcoming public hearing. City Council decisions on land use have specific guidelines that must be followed. A review of the material will be helpful for all of us.

The Personnel Policy items that need to be discussed by City Council and the changes that were recommended by ICRMP will be distributed and be reviewed at the first City Council meeting in February. Kyla will send them out this month so there is plenty of time for review and research prior to the meeting.

I have a couple programs I would like to implement this year to increase awareness of City policy, encourage community involvement and recognition of the positive aspects of living in Meadows Valley. I will bring those ideas to the City Council so you can be a part of the ongoing effort to keep the public informed and involved.

Ordinance TBD-2021

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NEW MEADOWS, ADAMS COUNTY, IDAHO, AMENDING TITLE 4, CHAPTER 5 SECTION 6, OF THE NEW MEADOWS CITY CODE AS FOLLOWS: IN SECTION 4-5-6, ADD THAT ALL RECREATIONAL VEHICLES WILL COMPLY WITH CITY CODE FOR THE ZONE IN WHICH THEY RESIDE, AND THAT GENERATORS SHALL ONLY BE IN OPERATION BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 7 A.M. AND 9 P.M.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW MEADOWS, IDAHO:

Section 1: Title 4, Chapter 5, Section 6, *Permit Process*, is hereby amended as follows, to wit:

4-5-6 Permit Process

Landowners are required to complete an application process prior to a permit being issued. The permit shall include the location of the land where the RV is to be placed and where on the land it will be placed, the permit type desired, photos and exhibits as necessary, a copy of the registration of the RV, photo identification of the property owner, a copy of the deed for the property or other proof of ownership and a signed affidavit indicating the truth and correctness of the application along with all fees necessary or being charged.

Recreational vehicles will comply with city code for the zone in which they reside. Generators shall only be in operation between the hours of 7 A.M. and 9 P.M.

Permits may be issued by the City Clerk's Office for emergency RV use, transitional RV use and vacation RV use.

The City Clerk may deny a permit based only on lack of required information.

Displacement RV use permits will be issued by the New Meadows City Council after being reviewed by the New Meadows Planning and Zoning Commission (or City Council if P&Z is not active) and compared to the current or adopted New Meadows Zoning Code. The New Meadows City Council decision is final.

When an application is approved, a permit shall be issued that bears the type of permit being issued, the date in which it is valid and its expiration date. The permit shall be displayed in the window of the RV that can be seen from the abutting street. (Ord. 357-2019, 5-20-2019)

Section 2: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval, and publication, according to law.
