A RESOLUTION AWARDING THE DEMO AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE PORT OF NOME LAUNCH RAMP REPLACEMENT PROJECT TO STG, INC.

WHEREAS, the Nome Port & Harbor serves an important role as a maritime transportation hub in Western Alaska supporting communities of the Norton Sound and additional Bering Strait Region for the transshipment of fuel, cargo, equipment, and for the export of gravel and rock; and,

WHEREAS, the majority of Nome's homeported fleet operates in near-shore and Norton Sound waters, using Nome as a base by which to support their seasonal operations and protecting their vessels by overwintering in dry-dock at Nome; thereby relying on the harbor infrastructure to serve that need and be available for their use; and,

WHEREAS, the region's commodities are transshipped through the Port of Nome, which also serves as a strategic resupply facility and laydown area for commercial marine operations that service the Western Alaska coastline from the Yukon River to the Chukchi & Beaufort Seas, and whom also rely on harbor infrastructure to effectively load/unload commodities; and,

WHEREAS, the limited ice-free season afforded to the Arctic region dictates that activity occur as efficiently and effectively as possible, with little flexibility for essential infrastructure components to be unreliable or at risk of failure, as this delays operations and increases risks of maritime operations and schedules, driving up transportation costs for goods and services; and,

WHEREAS, the City has been awarded \$2,276,467 in funding from the U.S. Economic Development Administration Public Works Program based on economic distress criteria, as well as matching funds of \$300K from Norton Sound Economic Development Corporation, and \$377,663 from the City of Nome to fund construction, engineering, contract admin, and inspection; and,

WHEREAS, the City advertised for bids to be publicly opened and read on March 11, 2021, and the City received and opened two bids on March 11, 2021, identifying STG, Inc. as the lowest qualified and responsive bidder with a base bid of \$2,954,130 for the Launch Ramp Replacement Project; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Nome wishes to move forward with the project, in an effort to replace the damaged ramp and to ensure reliability for transshipping, vessel launching and removal.

NOW, **THEREFORE**, **BE IT RESOLVED** that the Nome City Council hereby awards the Port of Nome Launch Ramp Replacement Project to STG, Inc. for \$2,954,130.

The City of Nome respectfully submits the attached packet of documents, reflecting a request to EDA Region X for additional program funds to support an overrun in project costs for the Inner Harbor Launch Ramp Repair Project. The funding gap has prevented the City from awarding construction of the project as all bids received exceeded available funding.

Based on a modified scope of work with an updated construction cost estimate (see Table 1), the City is confident that all components of the project can be constructed if an additional \$584,054 in EDA funds were allocated through the Public Works program. The City has approved the 20% applicant match of \$569,117 to fund the increased cost-share of the project.

This 20% cost-share is comprised of \$269,117 in municipal funds obligated to the project by the Nome Common Council, and \$300,000 in grant funds from Norton Sound Economic Development Corporation (NSEDC), under their Large Infrastructure Program (see attached). NSEDC serves as the local Community Development Quota (CDQ) group for the Bering Strait Region.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF NOME TO APPLY FOR AND PARTICIPATE IN THE USDOT INFRA DISCRETIONARY GRANT PROGRAM FOR THE FUNDING OF THE SNAKE RIVER MOORAGE AND VESSEL HAULOUT FACILITY PROJECT

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT) administers the Infrastructure for Rebuilding America (INFRA) Grant Program, which supports surface transportation projects necessary to facilitate direct intermodal, transfer or access into or out of a facility that will improve commodity movement throughout a region or freight network; and

WHEREAS, the City of Nome owns the Port & Harbor, which serves as the regional maritime hub facility for over fifty (50) western Alaska communities, transshipping fuel, cargo and gravel throughout the region during the ice-free season, serving as the critical transportation network link that enables equipment, fuel, household goods, and basic life-sustaining necessities to be delivered to the regional rural network; and

WHEREAS, Nome's Inner Harbor has experienced an escalation in vessel congestion in the last eight (8) years, which has created numerous vessel incidents and significant delays in the transshipment of goods and services across the region and caused vessel overcrowding that has impacted subsistence activities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Nome identified the Snake River Moorage and Vessel Haulout Facility as one of the priority projects in the Port of Nome Strategic Development Plan in an effort to increase shipping efficiencies deemed critical in the limited ice-free maritime window; and

WHEREAS, barge operators have demonstrated written project support in an effort to reduce risks of conflicts with smaller vessels that result in damage and potential crew injury, as well as exponentially increase shipping inefficiencies that cause delays in the delivery of equipment, materials and supplies that are on tight construction deadlines in the short ice-free season; and

WHEREAS, Nome Eskimo Community, has agreed to partner as a co-applicant on this grant funding opportunity and concurs that the project aligns well with the needs of the community and region.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Nome Common Council supports application to the USDOT INFRA Grant Program for development of the Snake River Moorage and Vessel Haulout Facility Project, and agrees, subject to selection by USDOT, to enter into a grant agreement with USDOT for an INFRA Discretionary Grant.
