Agenda Item

- 1. Community Action Lab Content Discussion: Discussion with the Strong Towns AD HOC Committee regarding the topics shared through the Norman Community Action Lab, with special focus given to how Norman utilizes sales tax to fund local projects. This is the second of three public workshop presentations with the Community Action Lab program. This event is an opportunity to discuss issues that are important to the Norman Community with neighbors.

- Cameron Brewer stated that the 5 items that the Leadership Team has interest in is ADU, pattern zoning, minimum lot sizes, reviewing codes and policies, and barriers to medium-density housing.
