APPROVAL OF THE JUNE MINUTES

MONTHLY STATISTICS AND UPDATES

Ashley Battiest gave an overview of the shelter statistics from the months of June through September. The shelter was incredibly busy through the summer months. In June and July the live release rate was around 90%, and in August and September it was around 94%. The shelter remained over capacity for most of this time. The owner surrender list continued to grow, as staff were only able to accommodate a few animals each week being owner surrendered.

Mark Howery asked about the canine influenza in local shelters. Dr. Amy Tyler said that we had not seen the influenza at Norman Animal Welfare, but that staff had a protocol in place if anyone noticed symptoms.

Dr. Tyler spoke about the shelter's continuing local efforts to provide more spay/neuter service to the community. She has partnered with Norman Caravans and Best Friends of Pets to target members of our community who need the most assistance with spaying and neutering their pets, and she continues to work those surgeries into her weekly schedule at the shelter.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

1. Summary of July-September Dog is My Co-Pilot Flights

Kellee Robertson discussed the success of the partnership NAW has with Dog is My Co-Pilot and the transport flights that have occurred this year. The July flight took 92 animals from Norman Animal Welfare to different rescues in Oregon and Colorado. In September, the shelter sent 35 total dogs and puppies on the flight from Norman. That flight had a combination of dogs and puppies from NAW and puppies from a local rescue that needed placement. The last flight for the year will be on October 19.
