# FINANCE COMMITTEE MINUTES January 20, 2022

#### DISCUSSION REGARDING THE MID-YEAR BUDGET REVIEW

Anthony Francisco stated that we continue to see record sales tax collections. We project that by the end of the fiscal year we will have about \$7 million more in collections for the General Fund than what we budgeted. The Committee agreed to deposit \$183,000 in the Rainy Day Fund to get the balance up to the 5% target. The Committee also agreed by consensus to recommend appropriating General Fund balance for a City Vehicle Wash Facility (about \$750,000) and accessibility improvements at Andrews Park (\$350,000).

We now project to not have a negative fund balance at the end of the fiscal year for the Norman Forward Fund. We project to have a surplus of \$8.9 million in the General Fund and have a few projects that this surplus could be applied.
