Billy Jewell - Ward 5


Mr. Jewell said he felt Council was not listening to residents and expressed frustration with the evening's events.

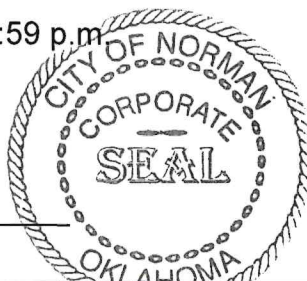
