#### Notes:

30 of these 94 guests are working or have income. 100% of those reported not having enough income to afford rent.

26 guests have a physical disability limiting their ability to work.

11 guests reported having a chronic health condition limiting their ability to work.

5 guests have developmental disabilities.

In October 2023, we assisted six guests to return to the city in which their family lives.

In October 2023, we helped 22 guests access their ID, Birth Certificate and/or social security card.

In October 2023, 10 of these guests moved into permanent housing here in Norman or a housing program offered by Food and Shelter.
