WIXOM ROAD REHABILITATION PROJECT

This spring, rehabilitation work will begin on Wixom Road from just south of Grand River Avenue to Ten Mile Road. This includes almost two miles of asphalt resurfacing, adding a left turn lane and new concrete curb and gutter.

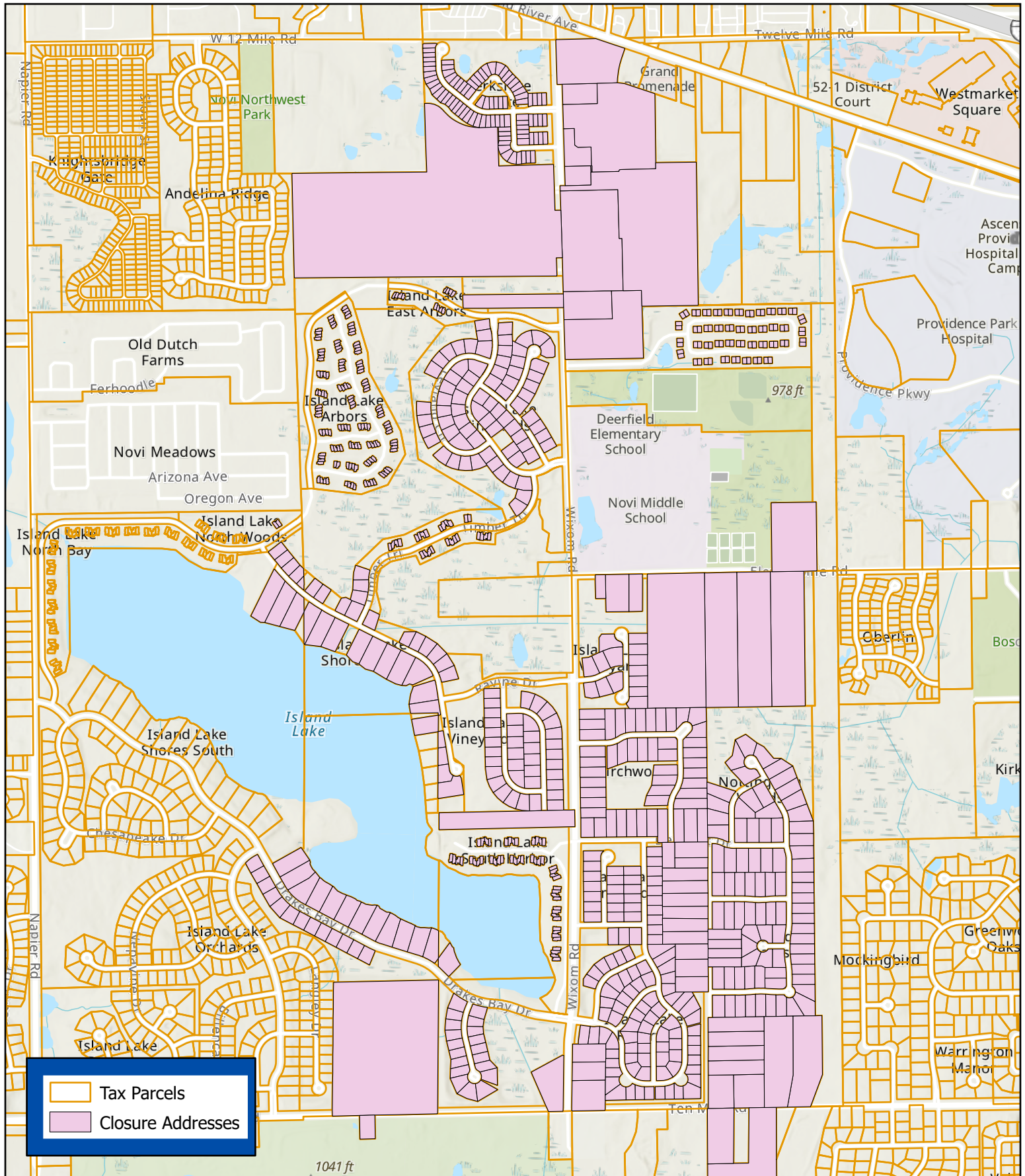
Throughout the duration of the project, one lane of **NORTHBOUND** only traffic will be maintained. Work is expected to be complete in late fall of 2024.
