7. Consideration of One-way Parking on Assigned Streets

The City Manager explained that he and the Public Works Director have assessed several streets to consider one way parking. He foresees this to be an ongoing project and he will be seeking participation from the residents of the affected streets.

Council member Perry mentioned that he had asked the City Manager to look into this problem and had developed a list of streets that needed attention. The streets are Thompson Avenue, Washington Avenue between School Street and Park Street, the bottom of Mayfair, Chestnut Street between Park and Richards Street, the alley behind the Pawn Shop, Lee Street, and Rhodes Street.

If the City Manager's approach does not work, he would like to see more aggressive action taken.

8. Approval for Mold Assessment of the Former BB&T Building and New City Hall

Councilmember Perry received estimates from three mold assessing/remediation companies for the purpose of inspecting the former BB&T building for mold. The price ranges from \$300 to \$2,200.

The City Clerk-Treasurer explained that this amendment to OHMC 4.02.70 will change all license fees to \$15.00 except for contractors, handyman, and alcohol license. The amendment to OHMC 4.08.150 will remove the B&O Tax exemption for rental properties.

A representative with the WV Community Development Hub explained the Hubcap Program and how it could benefit the City of Oak Hill. The Community Development Hub is applying for USDA funds for the Hubcap program and a participation of \$2,500 would be required from us.

Whereas, the Structural Inspection Board (SIB) convened with a quorum on August 17, 2021, at 1:00 p.m., and

Whereas, the structure located at 137 Broadway was reviewed, and

Whereas, the property was defined by the City Manager as property owned by Erin Runyon, 520 Evans Rd., Oak Hill, WV 25901, and

Whereas, the structure is described as Pt Lot 1 all 2 Harlem Hts. Annex 1, District 9, Map 7, Parcel 116, Parid 09 70011600000000, and

Whereas, parcel 117 was inadvertently not included in the sale with parcel 116 is described as Pt Lot 1 Harlem Hts., District 9, Map 7, Parcel 117, Parid 09 70011700000000; it remained in the previous homeowner's name, Marcellis & Maurice Lindsay, 294 VIA Felicia, Newbury Park, CA 91320, and

Whereas, parcel 117 was sold in the 2015 land sale to the State of West Virginia, and

Whereas, the owner of parcel 116 purchased parcel 117 from the State; no deed had been obtained;

Whereas, the structure burned in the Fall of 2020, was gutted, and

Whereas, the SIB determined that defects described within the Codified Ordinances of the City of Oak Hill, Section 11.04.010 (a) were present in the structure, and

Whereas, there were no occupants of said structure, and

Whereas, the Board was undivided and voted to have the structure demolished, and

Whereas, the finding of fact together with a Notice advised the owner to appear before Council to show cause why the structure should not be ordered to be demolished, and

Whereas, the Board requested Council to examine and consider the findings and recommendations made.

Whereas, a Notice was posted on the property on August 30, 2021, and

Whereas, the Notice was executed by the Fayette County Sheriff's Dept. on Sept. 6, 2021, and

Whereas, an Order to demolish the structure was issued by Council on October 11, 2021, and

Whereas, the order was executed by the Fayette County Sheriff's Dept. on November 4, 2021, and posted on the property on November 30, 2021, and

Whereas, the property owner and her attorney appeared before Council on December 13, 2021, stating she had full ownership of the property and requested Council to issue a stay on the demolition while she attempts to sell the property; the buyer was present at the meeting and planned to bring cost estimates and plans to the March council meeting, and

Whereas, the property was purchased on March 2, 2022, by Dewayne Hopkins, ILH Holdings LLC, 303 Broadway Ave., Oak Hill, WV 25901, and

Whereas, the new owner failed to bring cost estimates and plans to the March council meeting; the City Manager conveyed the city's attorney's recommendation to table the resolution until April's Council meeting, and

Whereas, the new owner failed to address the code violations to demolish the structure located at 137 Broadway Ave.

Therefore, be it resolved Oak Hill City Council authorizes the performance of demolition under the City's supervision and control on this April 11, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Oak Hill stands with the Ukrainian people and its government in opposing Vladimir Putin’s invasion and war against this democratic nation and expresses profound support for Ukraine at this difficult time while calling upon Russia to halt this deadly and unconscionable aggression against a peaceful neighbor.
