1. Discussion of the proposed Library budget

Susan Macken presented the budget to Council

2. Discussion of the proposed Wellness and Rec Center Budget

Jessica Burkhart presented the Wellness Center and Recreation budget to council.

Burkhart informed council that the Wellness Center received a grant so it will break even this year. The Wellness Center continues to work within the \$20,000 to \$30,000 loss each year.

Payne wanted to see the city work toward no loss for the Wellness Center.

Seeders also expressed concern that the center should lose less money.

Mulfinger informed the council that a policy decision would have to be made to have the Wellness Center break even.

Weber said the Wellness Center is a service for the community and an amenity that makes us an attractive place to live.

Burkhart presented the Wellness Center CIP and Rec CIP.

A brief discussion was held over the floor replacement in four years.
