#### 1. Discussion on Council Goals

#### Airport

 Council wants to continue with the airport breaking even each year. Council would like to look into a service that provides airport administration. Staff should proceed with the fuel improvements as needed.

### Wellness Center

- o Council wants to see a reduction in the loss by 25 percent.
- o Council wants to see more members for the center with more corporate members.

### Landfill Commission Recycle Bins

- o City Council wants the Landfill Commission to take more responsibility for the bins.
- o The Commission should find the location for the bins and keep the sight clean.
- City Council will vote to suspend payments to the commission until the commission acts on some of the requests from the city

#### Utilities

- o Council wants to see fees reflect usage for water and wastewater
- o Council does not believe residents should be paying for the treatment of industrial water
- O The Council wants to continue minimum increases but does not want to see a large increase

### Audit

 City council directed staff to work on all findings from the auditor within the year they are found

### Abatement Officer

 Council wanted to look into privatizing the inspections of rental properties so that current staff can focus on code enforcement
