- A. Reports from Commission Chair Rae Turnbull:
- a. Brief general review and clarification of the Arts Commission's role as a Public Art advisory body, and its separate role as manager of the Orland Art Center.
- b. Update on efforts to make businesses aware of the concept of Public Art, using a flyer mailing to all businesses. (Flyer designed by Community liaison Laurie LaGrone.)
- 7. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION OR ACTION
- A. Update on Water Tower aesthetics: The foundation will be poured in February. The tower will be composed of welded steel panels which will go up one at a time in March. Galvanized steel presents a much more complicated surface preparation painting a mural. This highly specialized prep process (see attachment) is more costly and presents more risk for the durability of the artwork.

At this point in time, we need to decide on whether to forgo a mural and let our concentration center on landscaping aesthetics, along with the wrought iron

fencing we already approved (as opposed to chain link) These two factors can create a very pleasing visual aesthetic for the project, with less deterioration over time.
