#### CLOSED SESSION ENDED AND RECONVENED TO REGULAR SESSION AT 6:30 PM.

**REPORT FROM CLOSED SESSION -** Mayor Romano announced that Council met with City Staff and City Attorneys Scott Drexel and Greg Einhorn in Closed Session to conference with real property negotiators, as noted on the Closed Session agenda, Mayor Romano shared that there was no reportable action.

#### PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

## ORAL AND WRITTEN COMMUNICATIONS PUBLIC COMMENTS:

County resident Valerie Johnson provided an update on the newly approved feline surgery center at Hidden Sanctuary. Marjorie Palmer expressed her support for the project.

Jake McDonald shared concerns regarding fair representation and voting rights within the City of Orland and requested that the topic be brought forward for discussion at a future meeting. The speaker also submitted supporting documents to staff for review.

**ACTION**: Councilmember McDermott moved, seconded by Councilmember Smith, to approve the consent calendar as presented. Motion carried by a voice vote 5-0.

#### **ADMINISTRATIVE BUSINESS**

#### **Budget Discussion with RGS**

City Manager Joe Goodman provided background on the current preliminary budget, which was adopted on June 17, 2025, with a commitment to revisit it by October 2025 to develop long-term strategies for achieving a structurally balanced budget. Mr. Goodman reviewed budget deficits dating back to fiscal year 2022–2023.

He noted that the deficit has grown over the past few years and cannot be resolved immediately. Mr. Goodman recommended that the Council approve the adopted FY 2025–2026 budget while the City conducts a thorough evaluation of all funds. He also reported that staff and RGS continue to identify errors and omissions in the City's financial records related to the transition to the new software system.

Mr. Goodman presented the idea of hiring a part-time employee with accounting expertise to support the transition to Tyler, enhance staff capacity, and assist in identifying the structural changes necessary to achieve a balanced budget. He also shared that he has been working with RGS to prepare a structurally balanced budget outline for FY 2026–2027 that includes all City funds. Reviewing all funds will help the Council more effectively prioritize needs and gain a clearer understanding of the City's overall expenditures.

Unknown speaker suggested that an ordinance be created regarding the budget deficit.

Council discussed the possibility of hiring an additional employee with accounting expertise for a oneyear term to assist with financial management. The Council briefly discussed the current budget and the deficits from previous fiscal years.

**ACTION:** Councilmember McDermott moved, seconded by Vice Mayor Tolle, to Authorize staff to hire a part-time employee with accounting expertise for an initial one-year term, renewable upon successful performance, and proceed with the proposed process and schedule to evaluate the City's fiscal health and develop the structural changes needed to restore the General Fund to a balanced budget. Motion carried by a voice vote, 5-0.

#### Flag Display on Walker St. and Policy for City Property

City Attorney Scott Drexel addressed a community request to display Mexican flags in existing sidewalk holes along Walker Street during significant Hispanic holidays. Mr. Drexel explained that this issue

involves two parts: first, the need for the City to establish a formal flag display policy, and second, obtaining approval for any displays along Walker Street, which lies within Caltrans' right-of-way.

Mr. Drexel briefly provided background on the topic, stating that the City received a request to display Mexican flags along Walker Street during Cinco de Mayo, Día de los Muertos, and Mexican Independence Day. Mr. Drexel noted that the sidewalk holes in question were drilled approximately 25 years ago with Caltrans' permission and are currently used by the Orland Flag Society to display American flags on national holidays and other occasions. These displays occur without formal City oversight.

Mr. Drexel stated that this request highlights the fact that the City does not currently have a flag policy. He shared that many cities have begun developing such policies following a 2022 U.S. Supreme Court decision, which held that cities may control what flags are displayed on City property if the displays are considered government speech. Establishing a policy would formally designate flag displays as City speech rather than a public forum, ensuring clarity and consistency in future requests.

Mayor Romano opened the discussion to the public, stating that the City Council meets to "form a more perfect union" and to allow for justice and tranquility. He noted that everyone has different views and encouraged the community to be respectful of one another's freedom of speech and to be kind to their neighbors.

Vice Mayor Tolle asked whether the banner that crosses SR 32, which is used to promote City events, should also be addressed in the flag policy. City Attorney Drexel agreed, noting that including the banner would clarify what can and cannot be displayed.

#### **Public Comments:**

Orland resident Sarah Bosley shared her experience setting up the American flag with her children, who are in the Scouts. She expressed support for the City adopting a flag policy but raised concerns about flying commemorative flags.

County resident Heather Chavez reminded Council that their votes represent the City of Orland and its residents, not personal opinion, and expressed support for allowing the Mexican flag to be flown on City property.

City Attorney Scott Drexel clarified that any adopted policy would not affect the ability to fly the Mexican flag on private property or by private businesses; the policy would apply strictly to City property and rights-of-way.

County resident Dawn Garin expressed support for keeping the flagpoles limited to displaying only the American flag.

Orland resident Michaela Ponce shared information on how other communities display additional flags alongside the American flag and stated her support for allowing the Mexican flag to be displayed along SR32.

County resident Breanne Lowe spoke about Caltrans regulations regarding flags along state highways and expressed support for a flag policy for City-owned property.

County resident Mr. Savage expressed support for allowing the Mexican flag to be flown in recognition of Hispanic heritage.

Prina Vera shared her support for flying the Hispanic flag and spoke about her heritage.

Hilary Crosby expressed support for the City taking proactive steps on flag displays and requested that staff work closely with Caltrans in developing the policy.

County resident Jack Pendergrass shared his perspective as a veteran, supporting individuals' rights to fly any flag on private property but recommending that only the American flag be flown on City property.

County resident Sara King prayed for unity within the community.

An unknown speaker thanked the community for attending and sharing their views and spoke against being defined by a single flag.

Orland resident Janice Noffsinger stated that while the American flag is important, there is nothing wrong with flying other flags on private property.

An unknown speaker referenced America's history as a "melting pot" and expressed support for flying the Mexican flag.

Orland resident George Martinez spoke about freedom and shared that he helped drill the original holes along SR 32, which were intended for the American flag.

Orland resident Mr. Darby expressed opposition to flying only the Mexican flag but supported displaying both the Mexican and American flags together.

Orland resident Ms. Bippus spoke about her family's history and travels, stating she would only fly the American flag. She supported private displays of any flag but emphasized respect for the American flag.

County resident Vernon Montague, a founding member of the Flag Society, shared his belief that the American flag unites the nation and should not share a stage with any other flag. He also noted the importance of reviewing Caltrans regulations for displays along state routes.

County resident Eugene Cleek expressed support for flying only the American flag.

County resident Beth Borkland questioned why flags were displayed after Labor Day; Mayor Romano clarified that the City does not currently oversee the schedule for flag displays.

County resident Joannie Woods expressed appreciation for the community's engagement and support for flying the American flag on City property, while encouraging cultural celebrations through events, banners, or other displays.

Orland resident Sharon Lazorko spoke about community gathering spaces to celebrate cultural heritage and expressed support for limiting flags on City, County, and State properties to the American flag.

County resident Janet Jaunting shared her views on the American flag as a symbol and expressed concerns related to deportation.

Orland resident Judy Holzapel expressed support for flying the American flag on public streets.

An unknown speaker shared concerns about community members not feeling valued for their opinions.

County resident Laurel Cleek stated that while she respects all cultures, the American flag should be honored and elevated.

Kelly Day expressed pride in her Mexican heritage and support for flying the Mexican flag.

Orland resident Jaime Davis shared her experience becoming an American citizen, expressing pride in her Mexican roots but support for flying the American flag.

Erin Becerro expressed support for the City creating a formal flag policy.

Orland resident Jaime Lopez expressed concern that the issue of the Mexican flag had divided the community and encouraged kindness and unity.

Orland resident Alex Enriquez shared support for flying the American flag on SR 32 and offered ideas for when flags could be displayed.

Orland resident Jeanette Smith supported flying any flag on private property but limiting City streets to the American flag.

Orland resident Joseph Bauer spoke about heritage and what the American flag represents to him.

County resident Susie Smith questioned why flags were displayed on certain dates. Mayor Romano reiterated that the City does not currently control the flag schedule and stated that the agenda item was included out of respect for those who requested discussion.

County resident Valerie Johnson shared thoughts on community unity and concern about some residents feeling marginalized.

County resident Marissa Hoke stated that the American flag represents everyone and should be the only flag flown on City property.

An unknown speaker expressed support for flying only the American flag.

Orland resident Manuel Quintel, a veteran, spoke about what the American flag means to him and encouraged love and unity within the community.

Orland resident Earl Megginson thanked the Council for facilitating the discussion and allowing public participation.

Orland resident Kyla Supra shared that flying both the Mexican and American flags together could help strengthen community unity.

County resident Dee Dee Jackson spoke about being a minority and expressed concern that expanding the policy could lead to unintended consequences.

An unknown speaker expressed opposition to flying the Mexican flag on City property.

An unknown speaker shared her experience immigrating from Mexico and expressed support for flying only the American flag.

Councilmember Smith stated that the American flag represents all people and thanked the community for sharing their input.

Vice Mayor Tolle shared that he spoke with 30–40 Hispanic and Mexican community members about the issue, all of whom felt that flying another flag along Walker Street would be disrespectful to America. He referenced the City of Manteca's flag policy as a model and expressed support for a neutral flag policy for City-owned property.

Councilmember McDermott shared his experience working with the VFW to raise flags and emphasized unity and respect for differing opinions. He stated his support for freedom of speech and encouraged moving forward with respect and reason.

Mayor Romano thanked the community for their participation and stated his support for directing staff to develop a formal flag policy for City-owned property.

Councilmember Barr thanked the Flag Society for their volunteer service and suggested recognizing Mexican Heritage Month through banners.

City Attorney Drexel noted that selective approval of displays could pose risks and that the first step should be for the City to establish a clear flag policy, followed by coordination with Caltrans regarding Walker Street.

Following discussion, Council directed staff to develop a formal flag policy for City-owned property.

#### **Memorandum Of Understanding**

#### Glenn County Community Action Day - November 9, 2025

This Memorandum Of Understanding ("MOU") is entered into on \_\_\_\_\_ (the "Effective Date"), by and between Keep America Beautiful, a nonprofit 501(c)3 located at 1010 Washington Blvd., Stamford, CT 06901 ("KAB") and the City of Orland. KAB and the City of Orland may be referred to collectively as "the Parties."

#### **Description of Scope**

#### **Description of Project**

The City of Orland will work with KAB and our mutual partner organizations to host a climate action event in Orland, California on November 9, 2025. This will accomplish the following objectives:

- Engaging around 40-50 volunteers to work on a climate action event focused on planting native pollinator plants and beautifying the downtown street.
- Ensuring each volunteer is registered and participates in a hands-on volunteer climate action activity, including tree planting and related tasks.

#### Responsibilities of the Parties

#### The City of Orland:

The City of Orland will be responsible for:

- Jointly coordinating a team featuring KAB, Keep California Beautiful, and external local partners, including the City of Orland, the Honeybee Discovery Center and other organizations, in the planning and execution of the climate action event.
- Ensuring lunch and refreshments are provided for volunteers, utilizing zero waste or low waste options whenever possible.
- Jointly offering activity training, safety precautions, and educational context for all participating volunteers.
- Jointly identifying volunteer engagement outreach targets, and conduct event promotional outreach to a variety of media, social media, and external partners.
- Jointly compiling all volunteer registrations and event waivers.

Unless otherwise agreed to in writing by the parties, the above describes the City of Orland's complete responsibilities.

The work will be performed by a blended team comprised of personnel from the City of Orland, KAB, and other external partners.

In exchange for the obligations detailed above, KAB will be responsible for reimbursing PARTNER for mutually agreed upon tools, equipment, and supplies; food, refreshments, plates, cups, utensils and napkins; and preapproved subcontractor time and expenses. These costs shall not exceed \$4,500 without further authorization. KAB will also provide a registration platform for volunteers and will support volunteer recruitment efforts.

Base/minimum funding (regardless of volunteer count): \$2,500

- At least 30 volunteers secured: An additional \$1,000 for a total of \$3,500
- At least 40 volunteers secured: An additional \$1,000 for a total of \$4,500
- At least 50 volunteers secured: An additional \$1,500 for a total of \$6,000
- At least 60 volunteers secured: An additional \$1,500 for a total of \$7,500
- At least 70 volunteers secured: An additional \$1,500 for a total of \$9,000

In addition, funding for food, refreshments, plates, cups, utensils and napkins will be provided separately at up to \$15 per volunteer. This funding cannot exceed \$15 per volunteer without further authorization, and does not count towards the volunteer-based payment amounts detailed above.

# ORLAND CITY COUNCIL BOARD REPORT

October 21, 2025

#### Submitted on behalf of the Glenn County Transportation Commission

#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Prior to allocating Transportation Development Act (TDA) funds, the Glenn County Transportation Commission, acting as the transportation planning agency, is required to hold a minimum of one public hearing to receive comments on unmet transit needs that may exist and that might be reasonable to meet. This is one of four public hearings being held; the other three are to be held before the City Council of Willows, the Glenn County Board of Supervisors and the Glenn County Transportation Commission.

#### **RECOMMENDATION(S):**

Conduct public hearing to receive public comment on Unmet Transit Needs in Glenn County and forward comments to the Glenn County Transportation Commission for consideration.

#### HISTORY AND BACKGROUND:

In 1971, the California Legislature enacted the Transportation Development Act (TDA) to ensure "the efficient and orderly movement of people and goods in the urban areas of the state." The TDA provides two funding sources: the Local Transportation fund (LTF), a ¼-cent general sales tax collected statewide and the State Transit Assistance fund (STA) which is now derived from an excise tax on gasoline and diesel fuel.

TDA recognizes that rural counties have different transportation needs. Counties with a population under 500,000 as of the 1970 Census may use LTF funding for transit and local streets and roads provided that certain conditions are met first.

The TDA, Statutes and Administrative Code of Regulations, requires specific actions on the part of local transportation planning agencies. One of these requirements (Section 99401.5) is that the Local Transportation Commission (LTC) explicitly define the phrases "Unmet Transit Needs" and "Needs that are Reasonable to Meet" in terms of local conditions, and that these definitions be documented by resolution or within the agency's minutes. Definitions have been developed to both comply with legislative mandates and be responsive to actual community need within the TDA funding guidelines.

9. A.

Under TDA direction (Section 99401.5 (c)), the LTC has the authority to identify the unmet transit needs of their jurisdiction and those needs that are considered reasonable to meet. Staff has determined, through contact with Caltrans representatives, that clear and comprehensive definitions are helpful in ensuring clarity in this annual process. With the above in mind, the following discussion is offered:

An Unmet Transit Need can be found to exist when there is any identifiable group within the population that has no dependable and/or affordable access to community employment, medical, commercial, public, or social services. Transit needs are not static--they can fluctuate with such variables as unemployment, population demographics, land use and circulation patterns, and variations in the local economy. Because of this, transportation needs are annually re-evaluated and revised as necessary.

It was through this process that the need for a public transportation system was identified and implemented, which is Glenn Ride. Glenn Ride has been in operation for 25 years with ridership growing slight 2020.

#### **ANALYSIS/DISCUSSION:**

An unmet transportation need (as opposed to a desire) has, for purposes of our definition, two components:

1) A trip destination that provides a necessity of life, and 2) a physical or financial obstacle between the individual and the necessary destination, which the individual is unable to overcome.

Necessary trip purposes may be defined as follows:

- a) to obtain or maintain employment;
- b) to obtain non-emergency medical and/or dental care;
- c) shopping for necessities of life;
- d) to obtain social services such as health care, government funded nutrition programs, sheltered workshops teaching employable skills, County welfare programs, and education programs for physically and/or mentally handicapped individuals; and
- e) to obtain education
- f) for the maintenance of life, health, physical and mental well-being

The population groups with the greatest inferred needs are the very young, the handicapped, the economically disadvantaged, and the elderly. There may be considerable overlap among these groups; for instance, many of the elderly may be both economically disadvantaged and handicapped. However, it is not to be implied that all, or even most of these people are transportation-disadvantaged. The aspects described simply identify sub-groups of the population that may tend to contain a disproportionately large number of people with transportation difficulties (in contrast to the general population).

An identified transportation need can be reasonably met by determining whether or not a transportation service can meet established need and meet the criteria found in the Transportation

9. A.

Development Act. This requires a cost-benefit analysis and feasibility study of alternative transit systems compared with existing service, level of performance, and cost. In any event, the cost of any transit system cannot exceed the apportionment for the jurisdiction providing or supporting the service.

Attached are the Glenn County adopted definitions of "Unmet Transit Needs" and "Needs that are Reasonable to Meet". The Glenn County Transportation Commission and Regional Transit Committee/Glenn Transit Service aim to meet as many if not all transportation needs for County residents, and currently offers several services to address these needs, such as follows.

Glenn Ride is a public transit system that provides transportation services to the general public—there are no barriers to entry or restrictions, except payment of fare. Glenn Ride has been in operation since August 1998 and experienced consistent ridership growth until the COVID-19 pandemic. Though Glenn Ride has continued to meet its required fare box return, as mandated by the Transportation Development Act, limited services and safety measure mandates during the pandemic significantly decreased ridership numbers, though numbers have been steadily recovering and increased by almost 7% this last fiscal year.

Glenn Transit also operates a specialized paratransit program known as Dial-A-Ride. The program operates within 1-1/2 mile radius of the respective city halls of Orland and Willows, and to the Cannella/Huggins Drive area, Leisure Mobile Home Park, east of Orland, and the Willows Mobile Home Park, west of Willows. Individuals qualifying are those 60 years of age and older, permanently disabled, low-income social service assisted or low-income non-social service assisted (income guidelines are provided on the transit card application required for service). Transportation is door-to-door to each requested destination.

Glenn Transit also provides non-emergency medical transportation to qualifying Glenn County residents through its Volunteer Medical Transportation program. Volunteer drivers from the community provide transportation to individuals for medical appointments. Qualifying individuals are those 60 years of age and older, permanently disabled, low income social service assisted or low income non-social service assisted.

The GCTC has requested this time and advertised this meeting as an opportunity for residents in the community to provide input on transit needs within the Glenn County region.

# I. UNMET TRANSIT NEEDS 2025-2026

For the purposes of allocating Transportation Development Act funds, an "Unmet Transit Need" is hereby recognized by the Glenn County Transportation Commission (GCTC) if any one or combination of the following criteria is found to exist:

- 1. Transportation needs identified by the GCTC which are desirable, but have not yet been implemented or addressed.
- 2. Transportation needs identified by the GCTC which have significant support, but have not yet been implemented or addressed.
- 3. Transportation needs identified through the public hearing process, whether delivered in writing or public testimony.
- 4. Those transit needs which, through transit needs studies or other methods approved by the Commission, are included by the Commission in the Regional Transportation Plan for Glenn County and have been designated a high need to be implemented or funded.

The above criteria for determining "Unmet Transit Needs" is further supplemented by the following guidelines:

- 1. A population group must have been defined and located which, by reason of age, physical or mental impairment, economic disadvantage, or a combination of these, has no reliable or accessible transportation for necessary trips. The size and location of the group must be such that the feasibility of providing service shall meet the criteria as defined as reasonable to meet. ("service" is defined as whatever accommodation or need is being requested by the public or partitioner).
- 2. Transit needs are to be determined in light of the following definition of "Necessary trips":
  - A. A trip destination that provides a necessity of life, and presence of a physical or financial obstacle between the individual and the necessary designation, which the individual is unable to overcome. Necessary trip purposes may be defined as follows:
    - a) to obtain or maintain employment;
    - b) to obtain non-emergency medical and/or dental care;
    - c) shopping for necessities of life;
    - d) to obtain social services such as health care, government funded nutrition programs, sheltered workshops teaching employable skills, County welfare programs, and education programs for physically and/or mentally handicapped individuals;
    - e) to obtain education; and

- f) for the maintenance of life, health, physical and mental well-being.
- 3. Unmet transit needs specifically exclude:
  - A. Trips for social events, recreational, or religious purposes are not considered as necessary. It shall be the policy of the GCTC, however, to serve these desires if they can be served concurrently within the limits of other defined "transit needs".
  - B. Individuals requiring the assistance of a medical attendant (in addition to the vehicle driver) are not considered as needing a transportation service and shall be deemed to be more properly served by a medical emergency vehicle.
  - C. Trips of less than one mile in length made by individuals who are not elderly or disabled are not considered as "transit needs". An able-bodied person can walk this distance in a reasonable amount of time without undue physical strain. Provisions for the elderly and disabled are made through the existing dial-a-ride/paratransit system.
  - D. Minor operational improvements or changes, involving issues such as bus stops, schedules, and minor route changes.
  - E. Improvements funded or scheduled for implementation in the following fiscal year.
  - F. Future transportation needs.
  - G. Trips that would duplicate transportation services to the general public.

# II. REASONABLE TO MEET 2025/2026

An "Unmet Transit Need" identified under the above criteria and guidelines, as it pertains to the allocation of Transportation Development Act funds, may be found "Reasonable to Meet" only if the following conditions and standards of performance prevail:

Cost Effectiveness: 1) The new, expanded or revised transit service would not cause the responsible operator or service claimant to incur expenses in excess of the maximum allocation of Transportation Development Act Funds. 2) The new expanded or revised transit service would allow the responsible operator or service claimant to meet minimum state subsidy fare box and revenue ratios.

Community Acceptance: A significant level of support exists for the public subsidy of transit service designed to address the unmet transit need in Glenn County including, but not limited to, support from public groups and community meetings reflecting a public commitment to public transit.

Equity: The new, expanded or revised transit service is needed by, and will benefit, either the general public or the elderly and disabled population as a whole. Transit service cannot be provided for a specific subset of these groups.

Operational Feasibility: The new, expanded, or revised transit service must be safe to operate and there must be adequate roadways and turnouts for transit vehicles.

Financial Feasibility: 1) Supporting data indicates a sufficient ridership potential exists for the new, expanded or revised transit service. 2) Potential providers are available to implement the service.

ADA Conformity: The new, expanded, or revised transit service, conforming to the requirements of the American with Disabilities Act, will not impose an undue financial burden on the transit operator or claimant if complementary paratransit services are subsequently required.

System Impact: The new, expanded, or revised transit service will not result in a negative impact on the overall system's measures of efficiency and effectiveness, such as average passenger load per hour, average cost per passenger per hour, passengers per mile, cost per mile, and cost per hour.

Impact Limits: 1) Transit services designed or intended to address an unmet transit need shall, in all cases, provide coordination efforts with transit services currently provided, either publicly or privately, and transit services shall not duplicate services currently or hereafter provided either publicly or privately. 2) No transit need shall be determined reasonable to meet until it has been reviewed and evaluated to the satisfaction of and obtained subsequent approval from the Glenn County Transportation Commission.

#### CITY OF ORLAND STAFF REPORT MEETING DATE: October 21, 2025

SUBJECT: City Council discussion and possible action for Glenn County Notice and

Order for Orland City Dump (Discussion/Action)

#### **BACKGROUND:**

Glenn County Environmental Health Department has performed three site inspections (June 2024, December 2024 and June 2025) of the Orland City Dump located at the north end of County Road E. The City owned parcel is approximately 34 acres with roughly 660 linear feet along Stony Creek. During the County's inspection of the site, they noticed a portion of the creek bank was eroding and exposing old burn waste. The County is concerned further erosion could expose more burn waste and could impact water quality and public health.

On July 16, 2025 the County provided the City of Orland with a Notice and Order (Order) identifying two California Code of Regulations violations relating to 1) drainage and erosion control and 2) slope stability. In the Order, the County provided three corrective actions to mitigate the violations.

Attached are the Order, inspection reports and site photos for review.

If the City does not comply with the Order further enforcement actions could be imposed. Staff has already requested and been granted an extension from the County so the Council can have an opportunity to review the Order.

As part of the Order, the County provided a report, prepared by Geo-Logic, with three conceptual remediation alternatives for the Orland City Dump. The purpose of the report is to provide viable remediation alternatives to assist CalRecycle in reducing human and environmental health risks. This report is also attached for review.

#### ANALYSIS:

The three remediation alternatives prepared by Geo-Logic are:

- Alternative 1 Stabilization and Scour Protection
- Alternative 2 Gabion Retaining Wall Creek Bank Restoration
- Alternative 3 Clean Closure

The County has asked the City to consider and evaluate the three alternatives and prepare a Corrective Action Plan that includes which alternative the City would like to pursue and a timeline for completion. Based on the permitting required to work in or near Stony Creek, all three alternatives could possibly

require a year or more to complete the permitting process. Prior to and during the permitting process, improvement plans would be prepared and approved showing the scope of work to be completed. Once the permits have been received, the project would be publicly advertised and a construction contract awarded to perform the work.

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends City Council discuss the proposed Geo-Logic alternatives and provide direction to staff on which alternative is acceptable so a Corrective Action Plan can be prepared and submitted to the County.

#### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

Depending on the alternative chosen, CalRecycle has grants available to pay for a portion of the remediation costs. The City would be asked to contribute funds to cover any costs not covered by a CalRecycle grant.

Consider Policy Options and Potential Adoption of Resolution Establishing a Flag and Banner Display Policy for City Property and City-Maintained Rights-of-Way (Discussion/Action)

#### **SUMMARY:**

Per Council direction from the October 7, 2025, meeting, this Agenda Item presents two policy options for the display of flags on City property and City-maintained rights-of-way. These policies would establish clear guidelines, ensure constitutional compliance, and provide a framework for addressing flag display requests.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

At the October 7, 2025, City Council meeting, the Council directed staff to develop formal flag display policies for consideration. This direction arose from the recognition that the City currently lacks a formal policy governing flag displays on City property and City-maintained rights-of-way, and that recent community interest in flag displays, including a request to display flags for cultural holidays, has highlighted the need for clear guidelines.

Currently, the Orland Flag Society operates independently, storing flags on City property and displaying American flags along Walker Street on national holidays and other occasions without formal City oversight. The flags are displayed using holes drilled in the sidewalks approximately 25 years ago with Caltrans permission. This informal arrangement, while serving the community well for many years, lacks the legal clarity needed to address requests for alternative flag displays and could potentially be interpreted as creating a public forum.

The Supreme Court's 2022 decision in *Shurtleff v. City of Boston* provides important guidance for municipalities regarding flag displays. The Court held that cities must clearly establish whether flag displays on government property constitute "government speech" or a "public forum." If treated as government speech, the City may exercise editorial discretion

over which flags are displayed. If treated as a public forum, the City must remain viewpointneutral and cannot discriminate based on the message or viewpoint expressed.

Following the *Shurtleff* decision, many California cities have adopted formal flag policies to clarify that their flagpoles represent government speech rather than public forums. These policies help cities maintain control over their messaging while avoiding potential constitutional challenges. The absence of a formal policy leaves the City vulnerable to legal challenges and creates uncertainty about how to address flag display requests.

Additionally, the flag display locations along Walker Street appear to be within Caltrans' right-of-way rather than City property, which raises jurisdictional questions that should be clarified as part of establishing a comprehensive flag policy.

#### **ANALYSIS:**

Staff has prepared two policy options for Council consideration:

#### Option 1: Government Speech Only Policy

This policy limits flag displays on City property and City-maintained rights-of-way to official government flags and City event banners only:

- United States Flag
- · California State Flag
- City of Orland Flag (if adopted)
- Prisoners of War/Missing in Action (POW/MIA) Flag
- Banners for City-sponsored events and programs

#### This approach:

- Clearly establishes City flagpoles as government speech
- · Avoids any appearance of favoritism toward particular groups
- Minimizes legal risk and administrative burden
- Ensures all residents are equally represented under government flags
- Is the approach recently adopted by several California cities
- Includes provisions for City event banners to promote municipal programs and activities

#### Option 2: Government Speech with Limited Commemorative Flags

This policy allows official government flags and City event banners plus limited commemorative flags approved by City Council:

- All flags and banners allowed under Option 1
- Commemorative flags approved by Council resolution for specific time periods
- Strict criteria excluding religious, commercial, political, or electoral messages
- Maximum display period of 7-30 days
- Requests must come from Councilmembers, not the public

#### This approach:

- · Maintains government speech designation while allowing limited flexibility
- Permits recognition of significant historical events or causes
- · Requires Council approval for each commemorative flag
- Still protects against constitutional challenges
- Requires more administrative oversight

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

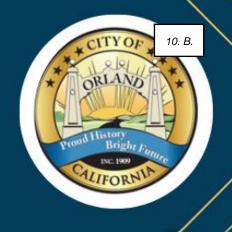
Staff recommends that the City Council:

- 2. Review the two policy options, receive public comment, provide direction on the preferred policy option with any requested modifications, and **direct staff to return** with a final resolution and policy for adoption at the next regular meeting; OR
- 3. Provide alternative direction to staff.

# A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORLAND ADOPTING A POLICY REGARDING THE DISPLAY OF FLAGS ON CITY PROPERTY AND CITY-MAINTAINED RIGHTS-OF-WAY

WHEREAS, the City of Orland ("City") owns and maintains various facilities and properties where flags are or may be displayed, including City Hall, other City facilities, and certain rights-of-way within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to establish clear and consistent guidelines for the display of flags on City property and City-maintained rights-of-way; and

WHEREAS, in *Shurtleff v. City of Boston*, 596 U.S. 243 (2022), the United States Supreme Court held that municipalities must clearly establish whether flag displays on government property constitute "government speech" or a "public forum"; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to designate flagpoles on City property and City-maintained rights-of-way as forums for government speech rather than public forums for private expression, thereby maintaining the City's authority to control the messages conveyed through flag displays on its property; and

WHEREAS, the display of flags on City property is a form of government speech through which the City expresses its official sentiments, values, and messages to the community; and

WHEREAS, the First Amendment to the United States Constitution permits the government to speak for itself and to select the views it wishes to express through its own speech; and

WHEREAS, California Government Code Section 431 requires that the United States Flag and California State Flag be prominently displayed upon or in front of public buildings; and

WHEREAS, California Government Code Section 434.7 requires that any United States Flag or California State Flag purchased by the City be made in the United States; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it necessary and appropriate to adopt a formal policy to govern the display of flags on City property to ensure compliance with applicable laws, maintain consistency in flag displays, and avoid any appearance of favoritism or endorsement of particular viewpoints while respecting the dignity of flag displays; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of this flag display policy serves the public interest by establishing clear, viewpoint-neutral criteria for flag displays while maintaining the City's ability to express its official government messages through the flags it chooses to display.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Orland as follows:

**SECTION 1. Recitals.** The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.

**SECTION 2.** Adoption of Flag Display Policy. The City Council hereby adopts the Flag Display Policy for City Property and City-Maintained Rights-of-Way, attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.

**SECTION 3. Government Speech Designation.** The City Council hereby declares and establishes that all flagpoles on City property and City-maintained rights-of-way are designated as forums for government speech and are not intended to serve as public forums for private expression.

**SECTION 4. Implementation.** The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to take all actions necessary to implement this Flag Display Policy, including but not limited to:

- a. Ensuring proper display and maintenance of authorized flags;
- b. Coordinating with appropriate departments for flag procurement and installation;
- c. Establishing administrative procedures for the implementation of this policy;

**SECTION 5. Supersession.** This Resolution supersedes any prior resolutions, policies, or practices regarding flag displays on City property to the extent they are inconsistent with this Resolution and the attached Flag Display Policy.

**SECTION 6. Severability.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Resolution is held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution.

**SECTION 7. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

**SECTION 8. Certification.** The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and shall cause the same to be entered into the book of original resolutions.

### CITY OF ORLAND FLAG DISPLAY POLICY

EXHIBIT A TO RESOLUTION NO. 2025-\_\_\_

#### I. PURPOSE AND INTENT

- **A. Purpose.** The City of Orland ("City") hereby establishes this Flag Display Policy to provide clear and consistent guidelines for the display of flags on City property and Citymaintained rights-of-way.
- **B. Government Speech Designation.** The City Council declares that all flagpoles on City property and City-maintained rights-of-way are designated exclusively for government speech and do not constitute public forums for private expression. Through the display of flags, the City expresses its official governmental messages, values, and sentiments.
- **C. Constitutional Authority.** This policy is adopted pursuant to the government speech doctrine recognized by the United States Supreme Court, which permits governmental entities to express their own views and messages without being subject to First Amendment restrictions that apply to the regulation of private speech.
- **D. Equal Representation.** By limiting flag displays to official government flags, this policy ensures that all residents, regardless of origin, ethnicity, religion, or political affiliation, are equally represented under the unifying symbols of our federal, state, and local government.

#### **II. APPLICABILITY**

- A. Covered Locations. This policy applies to all flag displays on:
  - 1. City-owned buildings and facilities, including but not limited to City Hall, police and fire stations, parks and recreation facilities, and public works facilities
  - 2. City-maintained rights-of-way where the City has authority to control displays
  - 3. City-owned flagpoles in parks and other public spaces
- **B. Excluded Locations.** This policy does not apply to:
  - 1. Property owned or controlled by other governmental entities (federal, state, county, or special districts)
  - 2. Rights-of-way under the jurisdiction of other agencies
  - 3. Private property

#### III. AUTHORIZED FLAGS AND BANNERS

Only the following flags and banners may be displayed on City property and City-maintained rights-of-way:

- **A. United States Flag.** The flag of the United States of America, which shall be displayed in accordance with the United States Flag Code (4 U.S.C. §§ 1-10) and applicable federal law.
- **B. California State Flag.** The flag of the State of California, which shall be displayed in accordance with California Government Code Sections 430-439.

- **C. City of Orland Flag.** If adopted by the City Council, an official City of Orland flag may be displayed.
- **D. Prisoners of War/Missing in Action (POW/MIA) Flag.** The POW/MIA flag may be displayed in accordance with applicable federal and state law.
- **E. City Event and Program Banners.** Banners announcing or promoting City-sponsored events, programs, and activities may be displayed on City property and City-maintained rights-of-way, including on street light poles and other appropriate locations. Such banners constitute government speech and shall be approved by the City Manager or designee. Banners must relate to official City business, City-sponsored events, or programs in which the City is an official partner or sponsor.

#### IV. DISPLAY STANDARDS AND PROTOCOLS

- A. Order of Precedence. When multiple flags are displayed:
  - 1. The United States Flag shall always be displayed in the position of highest honor
  - 2. The California State Flag shall be displayed in the second position of honor
  - 3. The City of Orland Flag, if adopted, shall be displayed in the third position
  - 4. The POW/MIA Flag, if displayed, shall be displayed below all other flags

#### **B. Size and Condition Requirements.**

- 1. No flag shall be larger than the United States Flag
- 2. When displayed together, the United States Flag and California State Flag should be of equal size
- 3. All flags must be clean, in good repair, and suitable for display
- 4. Worn or damaged flags shall be promptly replaced and retired respectfully

#### C. Time of Display.

- 1. Flags should normally be displayed from sunrise to sunset
- 2. Flags may be displayed 24 hours per day if properly illuminated during darkness
- 3. Flags should not be displayed during inclement weather unless all-weather flags are used

#### D. Half-Staff Displays.

- 1. The United States Flag shall be flown at half-staff in accordance with Presidential proclamations, federal law, and orders from the Governor of California
- 2. The California State Flag shall be flown at half-staff whenever the United States Flag is at half-staff
- 3. The City Manager may order flags to be flown at half-staff upon the death of a City official or employee in accordance with established protocols

#### E. Raising and Lowering.

- 1. Flags should be raised briskly and lowered ceremoniously
- 2. The United States Flag should be raised first and lowered last
- 3. When displayed at half-staff, flags shall first be raised to the peak momentarily before being lowered to half-staff

#### V. PROHIBITION ON UNAUTHORIZED FLAGS AND BANNERS

**A. No Other Flags or Banners Permitted.** No flags, banners, or pennants other than those specifically authorized in Section III shall be displayed on City property or City-maintained rights-of-way.

- **B. No Third-Party Requests.** The City will not consider or accept requests from individuals, organizations, or groups to display flags or banners other than those authorized in this policy. This includes banners for non-City events, private organizations, or commercial enterprises.
- **C. Enforcement.** City staff shall remove any unauthorized flag or banner displays and may take appropriate enforcement action for violations of this policy.

#### VI. ADMINISTRATION

- A. Responsibility. The City Manager or designee shall be responsible for:
  - 1. Implementation and enforcement of this policy
  - 2. Procurement and maintenance of authorized flags
  - 3. Training staff on proper flag display protocols
  - 4. Coordination with other agencies regarding jurisdictional issues
- **B. Flag Procurement.** All United States and California State Flags purchased by the City shall be made in the United States in accordance with California Government Code Section 434.7.
- **C. Maintenance.** The Public Works Department shall regularly inspect and maintain all City flag displays to ensure compliance with this policy.

#### **VII. SEVERABILITY**

If any provision of this policy is held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect.

#### **VIII. AMENDMENTS**

This policy may be amended by resolution of the City Council.

#### CITY OF ORLAND FLAG DISPLAY POLICY

EXHIBIT A TO RESOLUTION NO. 2025-\_\_\_

#### I. PURPOSE AND INTENT

- **A. Purpose.** The City of Orland ("City") hereby establishes this Flag Display Policy to provide clear and consistent guidelines for the display of flags on City property and Citymaintained rights-of-way, while allowing limited recognition of significant historical events, causes, or commemorations through City Council-approved flag displays.
- **B. Government Speech Designation.** The City Council declares that all flagpoles on City property and City-maintained rights-of-way are designated exclusively for government speech and do not constitute public forums for private expression. Through the display of flags, including any commemorative flags approved by the City Council, the City expresses its official governmental messages, values, and sentiments.
- **C. Constitutional Authority.** This policy is adopted pursuant to the government speech doctrine recognized by the United States Supreme Court, which permits governmental entities to express their own views and messages without being subject to First Amendment restrictions that apply to the regulation of private speech.
- **D. Balanced Approach.** This policy balances the primary display of official government flags with the ability to recognize, on a limited basis and through official City action, significant events or causes that the City Council determines merit commemoration.

#### II. APPLICABILITY

- A. Covered Locations. This policy applies to all flag displays on:
  - 1. City-owned buildings and facilities, including but not limited to City Hall, police and fire stations, parks and recreation facilities, and public works facilities
  - 2. City-maintained rights-of-way where the City has authority to control displays
  - 3. City-owned flagpoles in parks and other public spaces
- **B. Excluded Locations.** This policy does not apply to:
  - 1. Property owned or controlled by other governmental entities (federal, state, county, or special districts)
  - 2. Rights-of-way under the jurisdiction of Caltrans or other agencies
  - 3. Private property

#### III. PERMANENTLY AUTHORIZED FLAGS AND BANNERS

The following flags and banners may be displayed on City property and City-maintained rights-of-way without additional approval:

- **A. United States Flag.** The flag of the United States of America, which shall be displayed in accordance with the United States Flag Code (4 U.S.C. §§ 1-10) and applicable federal law.
- **B. California State Flag.** The flag of the State of California, which shall be displayed in accordance with California Government Code Sections 430-439.

- **C. City of Orland Flag.** If adopted by the City Council, an official City of Orland flag may be displayed.
- **D. Prisoners of War/Missing in Action (POW/MIA) Flag.** The POW/MIA flag may be displayed in accordance with applicable federal and state law.
- **E. City Event and Program Banners.** Banners announcing or promoting City-sponsored events, programs, and activities may be displayed on City property and City-maintained rights-of-way, including on street light poles and other appropriate locations. Such banners constitute government speech and shall be approved by the City Manager or designee. Banners must relate to official City business, City-sponsored events, or programs in which the City is an official partner or sponsor.

#### IV. COMMEMORATIVE FLAGS

- **A. Definition.** A "Commemorative Flag" means any flag that symbolizes a historical event, cause, nation, or group of people that the City Council chooses to honor or commemorate as an expression of the City's official government speech.
- **B. Location Restrictions.** Commemorative Flags may only be displayed at City Hall flagpoles and shall not be displayed at other City facilities or on rights-of-way flagpoles.

#### C. Approval Process.

- 1. Only members of the City Council may request the display of a Commemorative Flag
- 2. Requests must be placed on a City Council agenda as a regular agenda item
- 3. The City Council must approve the display by majority vote at a noticed public meeting
- 4. Each approval shall specify the flag to be displayed, the duration of display, and the specific dates

#### D. Time Limitations.

- 1. Commemorative Flags may be displayed for a maximum of seven (7) consecutive days per approval
- 2. No more than six (6) Commemorative Flag displays shall be approved per calendar year
- 3. No single Commemorative Flag may be displayed more than once per calendar year

# **E. Prohibited Commemorative Flags.** The following shall not be approved as Commemorative Flags:

- 1. Flags promoting or opposing any religion, religious movement, or religious doctrine
- 2. Flags advertising commercial activities, businesses, products, or services
- 3. Flags supporting or opposing political parties, political candidates, or ballot measures
- 4. Flags advocating for or against pending legislation or regulatory matters
- 5. Flags containing obscene, offensive, or inflammatory imagery or messages
- 6. Flags that would violate the Establishment Clause or any other constitutional provision

#### F. Display Standards for Commemorative Flags.

- 1. Shall not be larger than the United States Flag or California State Flag
- 2. Shall be displayed below all permanent government flags
- 3. Must be in good condition and made of weather-appropriate material
- 4. Only one Commemorative Flag may be displayed at a time

**G. No Public Requests.** The City will not accept or consider requests from the public for Commemorative Flag displays. This restriction maintains the government speech nature of flag displays.

#### V. DISPLAY STANDARDS AND PROTOCOLS

#### A. Order of Precedence. When multiple flags are displayed:

- 1. The United States Flag shall always be displayed in the position of highest honor
- 2. The California State Flag shall be displayed in the second position of honor
- 3. The City of Orland Flag, if adopted, shall be displayed in the third position
- 4. The POW/MIA Flag, if displayed, shall be displayed in the fourth position
- 5. Any approved Commemorative Flag shall be displayed below all permanent flags

#### **B. Size and Condition Requirements.**

- 1. No flag shall be larger than the United States Flag
- 2. When displayed together, the United States Flag and California State Flag should be of equal size
- 3. All flags must be clean, in good repair, and suitable for display
- 4. Worn or damaged flags shall be promptly replaced and retired respectfully

#### C. Time of Display.

- 1. Flags should normally be displayed from sunrise to sunset
- 2. Flags may be displayed 24 hours per day if properly illuminated during darkness
- 3. Flags should not be displayed during inclement weather unless all-weather flags are used

#### D. Half-Staff Displays.

- 1. The United States Flag shall be flown at half-staff in accordance with Presidential proclamations, federal law, and orders from the Governor of California
- 2. The California State Flag shall be flown at half-staff whenever the United States Flag is at half-staff
- 3. Any Commemorative Flag being displayed shall also be flown at half-staff when other flags are at half-staff
- 4. The City Manager may order flags to be flown at half-staff upon the death of a City official or employee

#### E. Raising and Lowering.

- 1. Flags should be raised briskly and lowered ceremoniously
- 2. The United States Flag should be raised first and lowered last
- 3. When displayed at half-staff, flags shall first be raised to the peak momentarily before being lowered to half-staff

#### VI. ADMINISTRATION

- **A. Responsibility.** The City Manager or designee shall be responsible for:
  - 1. Implementation and enforcement of this policy
  - 2. Procurement and maintenance of authorized flags
  - 3. Training staff on proper flag display protocols
  - 4. Maintaining records of City Council approvals for Commemorative Flags
  - 5. Ensuring timely installation and removal of approved Commemorative Flags
  - 6. Coordination with other agencies regarding jurisdictional issues

#### **B. Flag Procurement.**

- 1. All United States and California State Flags purchased by the City shall be made in the United States in accordance with California Government Code Section 434.7
- Commemorative Flags may be provided by requesting Councilmembers or purchased by the City
- 3. Donated flags must meet the quality standards in this policy
- **C. Maintenance.** The Public Works Department shall regularly inspect and maintain all City flag displays to ensure compliance with this policy.
- **D. Records.** The City Clerk shall maintain records of all City Council approvals for Commemorative Flag displays, including the specific flag, dates of display, and Council vote.

#### VII. RIGHTS-OF-WAY UNDER OTHER JURISDICTION

For flag displays in rights-of-way under the jurisdiction of Caltrans or other agencies, persons seeking to display flags must contact the appropriate agency directly. The City does not have authority to approve flag displays in areas outside its jurisdiction.

#### **VIII. SEVERABILITY**

If any provision of this policy is held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect.
