

RESOLUTION 2026-01 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PAHOKEE, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE CITY OF PAHOKEE'S ANNUAL MLK PARADE AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION FOR A PARADE PERMIT FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION; PROVIDING FOR ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

The resolution title was read into the record by the Acting City Attorney and explained by the Interim City Manager.

3. RESOLUTION 2026-03 AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PAHOKEE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER TO SECURE A FIREWORKS VENDOR FOR THE CITY OF PAHOKEE'S JULY 4TH INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATION FOR AN

AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THIRTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$35,000.00); PROVIDING FOR ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

The resolution title was read into the record by the Acting City Attorney and explained by the Interim City Manager.

Vice Mayor Cowan-Williams moved to "table this event and it comes back on the agenda as a regular scheduled item". The motion failed due to lack of a second.

Commissioner McPherson moved to accept Resolution 2026-03 and inquired if the word "emergency" could be removed. Discussion ensued; however, there was no second.

Motion made by Commissioner Scott to accept Resolution 2026-03. Duly seconded by Commissioner McPherson and passed (3-1).


Motion made by Commissioner McPherson to adjourn the meeting. Duly seconded by Commissioner Scott and passed unanimously.
