

MINUTES PARADISE TOWN COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING – 3:00 PM – MAY 28, 2025

1. OPENING

The Special meeting of the Paradise Town Council was called to order by Mayor Crowder at 3:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers located at 5555 Skyway, Paradise, California who led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.
