



## Measure C Oversight Committee Meeting Minutes

4:00 PM – April 25, 2017

### 1. OPENING

The April 25, 2017 regular meeting of the Measure C Oversight Committee was called to order by Chair Trostle at 4:05 p.m. who led the pledge of allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

### 2. ITEMS

- a. **MOTION by Simonton, seconded by Hansen,** approved Minutes of the March 28, 2017 Regular Measure C Oversight Committee meeting. Roll call vote was unanimous with Fender, Knappen and Morris absent and not voting.

Dean Fender arrived at 4:09 p.m.

- b. Administrative Services Director, Gina Will provided a financial update on the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of the 2016/2017 Fiscal Year. Director Will highlighted the progress of projects from the Police Department, Animal Control, Fire Department and Public Works.

**MOTION by Fender, seconded by Jones,** approved the quarterly report from the Measure C Citizens Oversight Committee to the residents of Paradise for the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of the 2016/2017 Fiscal Year. Roll call vote was unanimous with Knappen and Morris absent and not voting.

- c. Discussion continued regarding the 2017/2018 Budget process.

Administrative Services Director Will reviewed the past finances and the difficult economic situation the Town was previously in. She also mentioned how Measure C has allowed the Town to put items back in the budget that had previously been deferred. Director Will informed the Committee that the Measure C budget for the current 2016/2017 fiscal year has been fully allocated with the Town Council giving direction to staff to maintain at least a 10% reserve from Measure C as contingency funds.

The Measure C Committee discussed the potential extension of Measure C, but acknowledged that there was difficulty in getting the message to the public about all the benefits that the sales tax revenues from Measure C have provided for the Town. Suggestions were made to place a message on the electronic sign in front of the Paradise Recreation and Park District, put an ad in the paper, make a presentation of the annual report to different groups and to the Town Council and the media.

The Measure C Committee would like to have presentations from the different departments to hear what the needs are for each area and make a final recommendation to the Town Council.

The next Measure C Oversight meeting is scheduled for May 23, 2017 at 4:00 p.m.
