Measure V Oversight Committee Meeting Minutes

4:00 PM - May 28, 2024

1. OPENING

The May 28, 2024, meeting of the Measure V Citizen Oversight was called to order by Vice Chair George Morris Jr. at 4:01 p.m. who led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

Vice Chair George Morris Jr. chaired the meeting.

2. ITEMS

- 2a. **MOTION by Larson, seconded by Rehmann,** approved minutes from the April 23, 2024, Measure V Citizen Oversight Committee meeting. Roll call vote was unanimous with Buzzard, Dye and Riley absent and not voting.
- 2b. Finance Director/Town Treasurer Aimee Beleu provided an overview of the proposed Measure V expenditure amendment recommendation to Town Council to include \$100,000 for a new Animal Control Supervisor vehicle.

MOTION by Larson, seconded by Simonton, approved the proposed Measure V expenditure amendment recommendation to Town Council to include \$100,000 for a new Animal Control Supervisor vehicle. Roll call vote was unanimous with Buzzard, Dye and Riley absent and not voting.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT

Fire Chief Garrett Needles appreciates the support the Committee has shown the Fire Department. Lieutenant Cameron Kovas provided an update on Police Department staffing. Town Manager Jim Goodwin provided an update on weed abatement and the Category 4 Tree Removal Program. Finance Director/Town Treasurer Aimee Beleu shared that two limited-term, grant funded Fire Inspectors started in early May, as well as an additional limited-term office assistant for the weed abatement program.

Paradise Residents Elected Officials Citizen Stakeholders

Paradise residents voted in Measure C, a half percent (0.50%) transaction and use tax, effective April 1, 2015, which automatically expired March 31, 2021. During the November 6, 2018 election, Paradise residents voted in Measure V, a ten year continuation of Measure C, effective April 1, 2021. The ballot measure requires a nine person citizen oversight committee to ensure the funds are spent in accordance with the voter approved measure. The language states, in part, the funds will be used to preserve public services such as police protection, fire suppression, street maintenance, animal control, and other services for residents of the Town of Paradise.

Attached is the preliminary quarterly report from the Citizen's Oversight Committee to the residents of Paradise for the 4th quarter of the 2023/24 fiscal year. The Committee meets quarterly and all meetings are open to the public. The Committee will report every quarter on revenues and expenditures. All reports will be available at Town Hall or on the Town of Paradise website at www.townofparadise.com.
