- 2b. Administrative Services Director/Town Treasurer, Gina Will gave a financial update for the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of the 2018/19 fiscal year. Stated revenues for the fiscal year are in line with what was expected. At the moment the Town is being conservative with spending of Measure C funds. It is anticipated that \$885,000 will be left over from the budget, Ms. Will recommends using it as a contingency fund.

Paradise Residents Elected Officials Citizen Stakeholders

Paradise residents voted in a half percent transaction and use tax (0.50%) effective April 1, 2015. The ballot measure requires a nine person citizen oversight committee to ensure the funds are spent in accordance with the voter approved measure. The language states, in part, the funds will be used to preserve public services such as police protection, fire suppression, street maintenance, animal control, and other services for residents of the Town of Paradise.

Attached is the quarterly report from the Citizen's Oversight Committee to the residents of Paradise for the 1st quarter of the 2019/20 fiscal year. and the final report for the 2018/19 fiscal year. The Committee meets quarterly and all meetings are open to the public. The Committee will report every quarter on revenues and expenditures. The next quarterly meeting is scheduled for January 21, 2020.
