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12. Discussion and possible action on Parks Mill Speed Study

Commissioner Hersey asked for this item to be included on the agenda. He advised that he has had lots of phone calls about truck traffic and high speeds on Parks Mill Road and that this has become an arterial road to avoid construction on Highway 441. He asked Public Works Director Frazier to come up and answer questions. Director Frazier advised that the road doesn't have all the signage it needs and that all Public Works can do is install advisory speed limit signs which reduce the speed limit by ten miles per hour below the posted limit. He recommends congested area signs be installed.

Motion to authorize the County Manager and Public Works Department to install congested area and 45 mph cautionary signs on Parks Mill Road from the Morgan County line to Gils Automotive.
