#### Jamie Steele's Speech 4/15/24 City of Petal Board of Aldermen Public Meeting

Is clear that this board based its most recent decision to allow a building permit on a fraudulent appraisal. I am not confusing the language of the appraisals. I am quoting the exact language used and have provided you with copies of the reference appraisals, invoked also ask that these are added to the meeting minutes bringht. The appraiser asserts that the property went up in value by \$50000 in just a matter of weeks while absolutely no work was done. Work started on January 6, 2022. You allowed and I believe encouraged the property owner of 106 Stevens St to continuously manipulate the numbers so an unsafe building could be rebuilt. The initial appraisal turned in which stated the cash value was \$35000 compared to the building permit request of \$50000 equated substantial improvement. The end, Why is it is odifficult to enforce city ordinances?

On the same note and as previously stated ordinance 9.36 has been ignored from the very beginning of this process and clearly applies to this situation. The building has been vacant since 2017 well over a year and should be made to conform with current code. You each received an email on March 2, 2022 very early on into this process that informed you of this applicable code but the city has chosen to and continues to ignore it and not enforce it.

Your decisions and your apathy have consequences. The property next to my house is a fire hazard. The fact that a c2 property can be a restaurant or a bakery where food is being cooked constantly just increases the potential for a fire disaster, a kide from the necessary buffer zone of 20 feet that should be provided, the current fence that stands between my house and the structure at 106 Stevens St is dilapidated and falling over. The property owner of 106 should be made to provide adequate fencing as well as an adequate buffer zone upon building at this location which is clearly outlined in our city ordinances.

I believe my children's speech was very misunderstood during the last meeting. They were actually saying how we know this board is composed of people with integrity that's why we have been so shocked and disappointed by your actions. How my concerns have been ignored, how the board refuses to enforce ordinances, how my lamily has been disregarded... that is what is shameful in this situation. I can assure you I am not ashamed of my actions or that of my family's.

All we are asking is that the rules be followed for our protection and for the protection of all future Petal residents. Please stop viewing me as an alderman's wife with some kind of pecuniary motivation here. My only motivation is as a mother protecting my children. I should not lose my rights as a difficer because my husband is an elected official and that is exactly what seems to have happened here. Please do the right thing, enforce the ordinances you were elected to enforce. Protect the residents of Petal including my family.



#### COPRELATION OF FINAL VALUE

An authoric of value of the subject property was obtained through the examination of all three approaches involved in the appraisal process.
