WHEREAS, The City of Petal intends to submit an application for federal funding assistance Through the United States Department of Transportation's FY25 Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity (RAISE) Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Petal proposes to Reconstruct Central Avenue to feature a multi-use path and medians, bury overhead power lines, install new street lighting, and rehabilitate or replace existing underground utilities and infrastructure from Railroad Street to Hillcrest Loop; and

WHEREAS, this project cost is estimated to cost \$27,463,110.29, and the project is eligible to receive \$25,000,000 in federal funding assistance through the FY25 RAISE grant program; and

WHEREAS, this project will require an estimated \$2,463,111.29 from funding sources other than the FY25 RAISE Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, Monies shall be made available monies for this project from the revenues generated by the City of Petal's Tourism Tax or through the issuance of a new General Purpose Bond; and

WHEREAS, Monies from the City of Petal's Tourism Tax or through the issuance of a new General Purpose Bond shall also be made available to this project to cover cost overruns in excess of \$27,463,110.29; and

WHEREAS, Current or future monies available through the City of Petal's Tourism Tax or the issuance of a new General Purpose Bond shall only be made available to this project if it is awarded funding through the FY25 RAISE Grant Program; and;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Petal, Mississippi:


