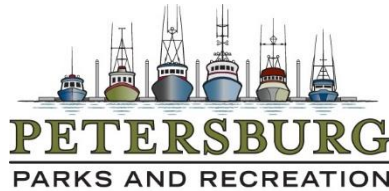
New basketball hoop system up for community gym. What can the advisory board do?
