Agenda Items:

Meeting Minute, of Nov 16, 2022 Adoption: John moved that the open and closed meeting minutes be
adopted as presented. Nancy seconded. Voting members unanimously approved the minutes.

Update From Soro Council: Nadi, gave the following:

1. Streetscape II: The past improvements to the town square and Main Street will be expanded soon. A
Borough meeting to discuss these new improvements will occur on January 30. This will be
followed by public information meetings.
2. The renovation of Skid Street Park: using allowable Open Space Trust funds is moving forward.
3. Landfill environmental studies are moving forward. The Council was recently given an update by
the Boro Planner regarding COAH housing and the landfill's environmental constraints. The
municipality is suitable for any residential development.

Status of Open Space Information on Boro Website: Additional information requested by the
Committee to be posted on its webpage has not yet happened. Liaison will reach out to the new Soro
Admins for more information.

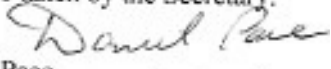
Public Input and Presentation Opportunities: Committee members discussed ways Pennington residents
could be better informed. More information on preservation opportunities. It was agreed that
additional documentation be placed on the Committee's web page. There would be a document explaining the
criteria used by the Committee to analyze potential preservation opportunities. Also, a document
identifies properties that the Borough has either presented or are currently under consideration. The Borough
supported without providing funds from the Open Space Fund. In addition, the Committee will explore
with the Board of Administration a way that residents could submit ideas on possible lands for preservation to the
Committee. For example, a link on the Committee's website that would enable email messages to be sent
to a suitable address.

Other Business: Alan gave an update on the Green Acres 2023 Funding, (a 100% application).
